

FARE ZONES:

Local Fares:
The local fare will apply for travel within one zone. Local transfers will only be issued southbound to passengers boarding between Elm Ave. in North Aurora and the Aurora Transportation Center.

Regular Fares:
The regular fare will apply for travel between two fare zones. Passengers transferring between 802/801 must have a regular Pace transfer.

Bus will stop upon signal to driver at any intersection along the route where it is safe to do so.

Pace is the Suburban Bus Division of the RTA

FARE INFORMATION

Peak fares are charged 6-9 a.m. and 3-6 p.m., weekdays, except holidays (New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas).

Reduced fares include children ages 7-11, senior citizens, and persons with disabilities (with RTA Reduced Fare Card), and students (high school or younger with appropriate identification) to and from school only on school days, between 6:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.

When accompanied by an adult fare paying passenger, a maximum of two children can ride **FREE** under age 7.
