

NEW COMMUTER SERVICE

CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY will further improve its service for loop-bound commuters at Northwestern and Union Stations in the morning rush hours, beginning on June 1, 1948.

A new bus route will be operated for the convenience of commuters traveling from those stations to the southeast section of the loop, Mondays through Fridays, from 7:38 a.m. to 9:09 a.m.

The buses will operate in Wacker Drive from Wabash Avenue to Randolph Street; west in Randolph to Canal Street; south in Canal, past the Northwestern depot to Adams Street; east in Adams, past the Union Station, to State Street; then south in State Street over the regular route of the Archer Avenue line.
