The following destination signs are carried on the front and side of trains:

ROUTE IDENTIFICATION MARKERS

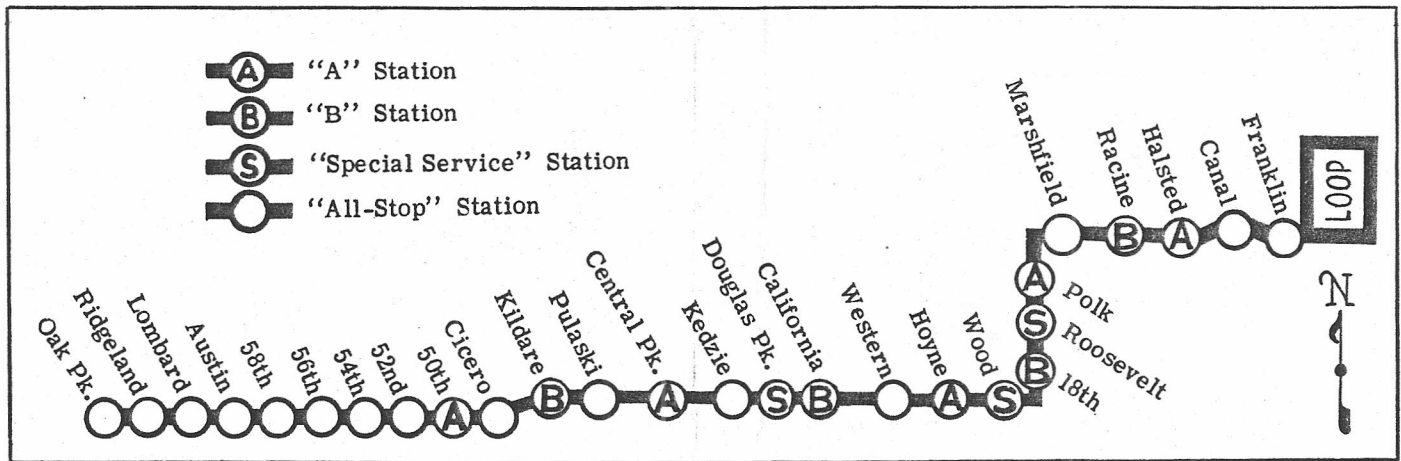
Facing the train, the route identification markers read, left to right, as follows:

DOUGLAS PARK MIDNIGHT SPECIAL SERVICE	
DOUGLAS PARK B	} RED-GREEN
DOUGLAS PARK B SPECIAL SERVICE	

NOTE: The first "A" or "B" train and the first train following an "A-B" period carries a green hand lantern at the front of the train in addition to the markers shown.

- "All-Stop" stations

RAPID TRANSIT SERVICE

Monday thru Friday, trains operate between the Loop and Oak Park station.

Saturday, Sunday, and Holidays, trains operate between the Loop and Cicero station.

TRAIN ANNOUNCEMENTS

Train announcements must be made to boarding passengers at stations giving the name, class, and other information concerning the train.

Example: A westbound Douglas Park "B" train at Canal station. Announce, "DOUGLAS PARK B TRAIN. THIS TRAIN DOES NOT STOP AT HALSTED."

Example: An eastbound Douglas Park "A" train at Kedzie station. Announce, "DOUGLAS PARK A TRAIN. THIS TRAIN DOES NOT STOP AT DOUGLAS PARK AND CALIFORNIA."

Example: A westbound Douglas Park "B" Special Service train at Marshfield station. Announce, "DOUGLAS PARK B SPECIAL SERVICE. THIS TRAIN DOES NOT STOP AT POLK, 18TH, AND HOYNE."

STATION ANNOUNCEMENTS

Station announcements must be made both cars; once when leaving a station and again when approaching the next station. Approaching an "All-Stop" station announce the station or stations to be skipped between the "All-Stop" station and the next "All-Stop" station. Unless the stations to be skipped are announced, a passenger on an "A" train, for instance, desiring to alight at a "B" station would be carried past the "B" station. He would have to ride to the next "All-Stop" station before being able to transfer to a "B" train in order to ride back to the "B" station he desired.

Example: A westbound Douglas Park "B" train approaching Marshfield station. Announce, "MARSHFIELD. CHANGE FOR POLK, ROOSEVELT, WOOD AND HOYNE. CHANGE FOR GARFIELD PARK TRAINS."

Example: An eastbound Douglas Park "A" train approaching Western station. Announce, "WESTERN. CHANGE FOR WOOD, 18TH, AND ROOSEVELT."

Example: An eastbound Douglas Park "B Special Service" train approaching Kedzie station. Announce, "KEDZIE. CHANGE FOR CALIFORNIA"

Example: A westbound Douglas Park "Special Service" train approaching Marshfield station. Announce, "MARSHFIELD. CHANGE FOR POLK AND 18TH."

"SPECIAL SERVICE" STATIONS

The "Special Service" stations (Douglas Park, Wood, and Roosevelt) have no Ticket Agent. Passengers enter by way of special turnstiles operated only by Rapid Transit System tokens. Passengers boarding at these three stations may obtain transfers from the Conductor or Triaman on the train. Service is provided at these stations about every 15 minutes during the A.M. and P.M. rush periods, Monday through Friday; at all other times service is provided about every 30 minutes.

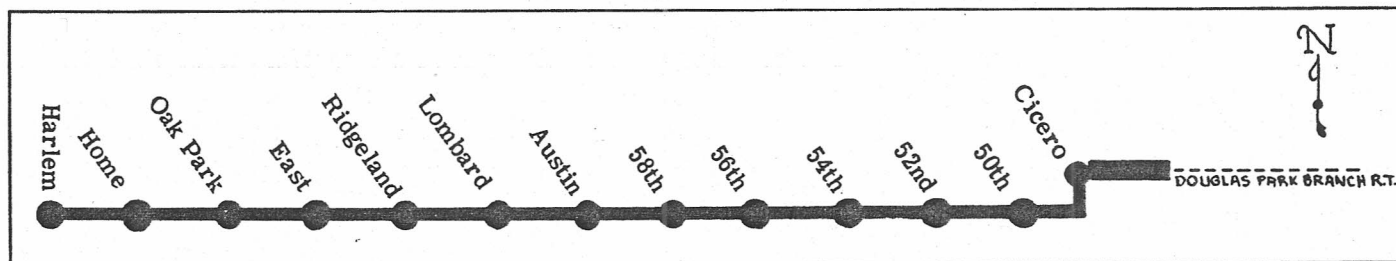

Route Of The Douglas Park Extension Bus



The Douglas Park Extension Bus Interurban Service

Surface system buses operate on Saturday, Sundays, and Holidays as feeder buses to the Rapid Transit. They operate on Cermak Rd. between Harlem Ave. and Cicero Station.

On eastbound trips, buses pick up passengers at the regular service stops but discharge passengers only at Cicero station.

On westbound trips, buses pick up passengers only at Cicero station but discharge passengers at the regular service stops.
