THE MONDAY THRU SATURDAY SERVICE OF THE  
WESTCHESTER-FOREST PARK BUS

Buses serve the area formerly served by the Maywood, Bellwood, Westchester service of the Garfield Park Branch, Rapid Transit System. Buses operate between a terminal at Desplaines station of the Garfield Park branch and a terminal at Canterbury St. and Westchester Blv'd. or a short terminal at Roosevelt Rd. and Westchester Blv'd.

THE SUNDAY AND HOLIDAY SERVICE OF THE  
WESTCHESTER-FOREST PARK BUS

Because Garfield Park trains do not operate at Desplaines station on Sundays and Holidays, buses operate between a terminal at Marion station of the Lake St. Branch, Rapid Transit System, and a terminal at Roosevelt Rd. and Westchester Blv'd.

THE SUNDAY AND HOLIDAY SERVICE OF THE  
GARFIELD PARK EXTENSION BUS SERVICE

Buses operate only on Sundays and Holidays and serve the area formerly served by the Garfield Park branch west of Laramie station. Buses operate between a terminal at Central station of the Lake St. Branch, Rapid Transit System, and a terminal at Ashland Ave. and Madison St. At this terminal passengers may transfer to the Westchester-Forest Park bus.



#### SUNDAYS AND HOLIDAYS

Trains operate between the Loop and Laramie station.

### CLASSIFICATION OF TRAINS

Trains on the Garfield Park branch are classified as follows: "Garfield Park A", "Garfield Park B", and "Garfield Park".

### CLASSIFICATION OF STATIONS

Stations on the Garfield Park branch are classified as follows: "A" stations, "B" stations, and "All-Stop" stations.

### TYPES OF SERVICE

Garfield Park trains serve Garfield Park stations as follows:

### TRAIN ANNOUNCEMENTS

Train announcements must be made to boarding passengers at stations giving the name, class, and other information concerning the train.

Example: A westbound Garfield Pk. "B" train at Canal station. Announce, "GARFIELD PK. B TRAIN. THIS TRAIN DOES NOT STOP AT HALSTED."

Example: An eastbound Garfield Pk. "A" train at Pulaski station. Announce, "GARFIELD PK. A TRAIN. THIS TRAIN DOES NOT STOP AT ST. LOUIS."

## STATION ANNOUNCEMENTS

Station announcements must be made twice in both cars; once when leaving a station and again when approaching the next station. Approaching an "All-Stop" station, announce the station or stations to be skipped between the "All-Stop" station and the next "All-Stop" station. Unless the stations to be skipped are announced, a passenger on an "A" train, for instance, desiring to alight at a "B" station would be carried past the "B" station. He would have to ride to the next "All-Stop" station before being able to transfer to a "B" train in order to ride back to the "B" station he desired.

Example: A westbound Garfield Pk. "B" train approaching Marshfield station. Announce, "MARSHFIELD, CHANGE FOR OGDEN, WESTERN AND SACRAMENTO. CHANGE FOR DOUGLAS PARK TRAINS."

Example: An eastbound Garfield Pk. "A" train approaching Kedzie station. Announce, "KEDZIE CHANGE FOR CALIFORNIA AND HOYNE."

## DESTINATION SIGNS

The following destination signs are carried on the front and side of trains:

## ROUTE IDENTIFICATION MARKERS

Facing the train, the route identification markers are, left to right, as follows:

"Garfield Pk." )	GREEN - WHITE
"Garfield Pk. A")	
"Garfield Pk. B")	GREEN - RED

NOTE: The first "A" or "B" train and the first train following an "A-B" period carries a green hand lantern at the front of the train in addition to the markers shown.


