Because of the lack of patronage, non-rush hour service on the Westchester Bus route, which has been operating experimentally between Canterbury Avenue and 22nd-Mannheim for five months, will be discontinued beginning Monday, February 23, 1953.

Traffic checks made in December, 1952, and again during January, 1953, indicate that a total of only ten riders use the twenty-two trips operated in this service on a typical weekday and only seventeen riders use the same number of buses on a typical Saturday.

Termination of this experimental extension service will not affect the rush hour buses which run to and from 22nd-Mannheim. The nine buses that make this run -- four in the morning rush hour and five in the p. m. rush period -- will continue to operate on present schedules.

Service on the main portion of this bus route -- between Canterbury Avenue, Westchester, and Desplaines Avenue, Forest Park -- will continue to operate as at present.
