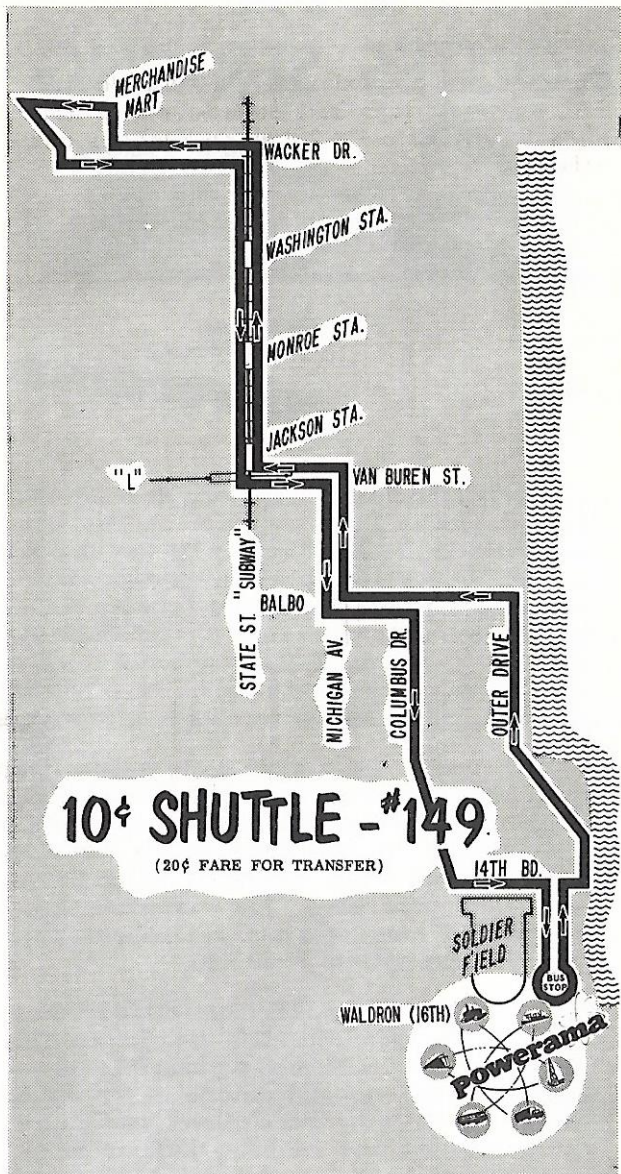

A CONVENIENT and easy way to reach the General Motors Powerama site on the lake front, south of Soldier Field, is by any one of three CTA bus routes which provide direct service to the area. Transfers between these three routes and other Surface and "L"-Subway lines may be made in the Loop area at any point where the direct Powerama service and other CTA routes intersect, converge or diverge.

Parking space for motorists attending the show, which runs from August 31 through September 25, is limited due to the fact that the exhibition site occupies some twenty acres of lake front area which ordinarily is available for parking automobiles. The Powerama show is open daily from 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. and Sundays from noon to 11:00 p.m.

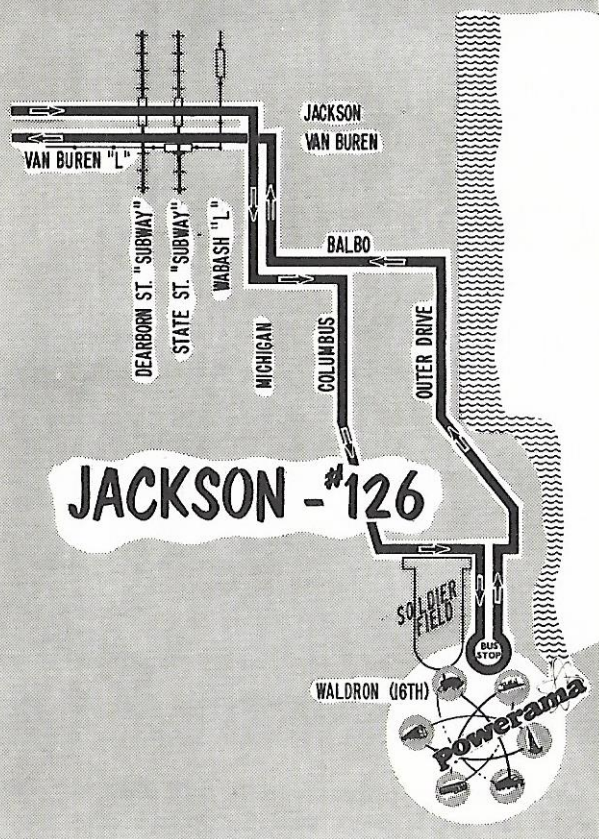
Three CTA bus routes—Michigan-State-Wacker (No. 149), Jackson (No. 126) and a special shuttle line from the Monroe parking lot and the Grant Park underground garage at the north end of the Loop—provide direct and quick service to Powerama, enabling those attending to forget traffic worries and avoid congested conditions caused by mass parking of vehicles.

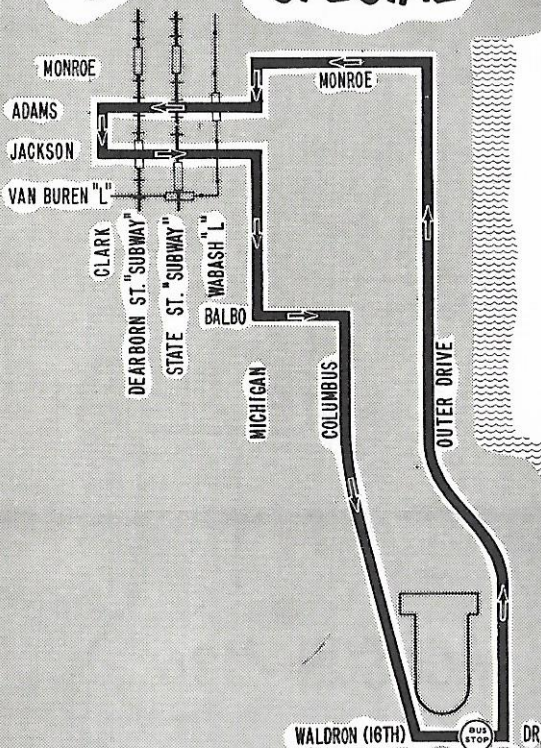
Operates from approximately 7:45 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. on week days and Saturdays. Does not operate on Sundays or holidays.
