

# South Deering (No. 27)

## Service Restored on Stony Island

EFFECTIVE SUNDAY,  
FEBRUARY 9, 1964

Service will be restored on Stony Island and 73rd street for about 19 hours a day starting Sunday, February 9, through the modified north terminal routing of CTA's South Deering (No. 27) bus route.

During the Owl periods on weekdays, Saturdays and Sundays, the South Deering buses will continue over their present routing. Also early Sunday mornings before Jeffery service starts, certain South Deering buses will be routed via their present routing. By these procedures, service will be provided along Jeffery between 73rd and the "L" station at 63rd and Stony Island via Jeffery and the Jackson Park drives when the Jeffery (No. 5) buses are not operating.

Northbound service on weekdays and Saturdays starting at 5:57 A.M. and on Sundays and holidays at 6:28 A.M. and continuing until 1:16 A.M., the next day, will be operated over the following route: west in 73rd street between Jeffery avenue and Stony Island avenue, north in Stony Island to Marquette road, and then in Jackson Park via Marquette drive, Cornell drive and Hayes drive to the 63rd-Stony Island terminal of the Jackson Park branch of the North-South "L"-subway route. Southbound service will be operated between 5:10 A.M. and 12:25 A.M., the following day, on all days of the week, in Stony Island between 63rd and 73rd, and then east in 73rd over the regular route.

South Deering buses will continue to provide service over the present northbound route between 1:45 A.M. and 5:45 A.M. on weekdays and Saturdays and between 1:45 A.M. and 9:10 A.M. on Sundays and holidays, and on the southbound route between 12:55 A.M. and 4:55 A.M. on weekdays and Saturdays and between 12:55 A.M. and 8:05 A.M. on Sundays and holidays.
