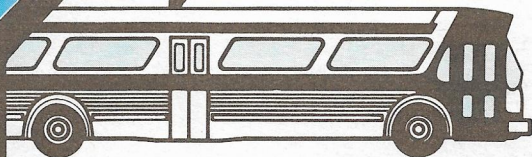
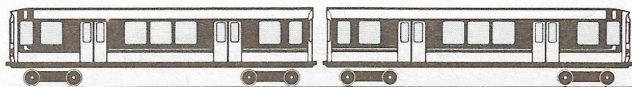
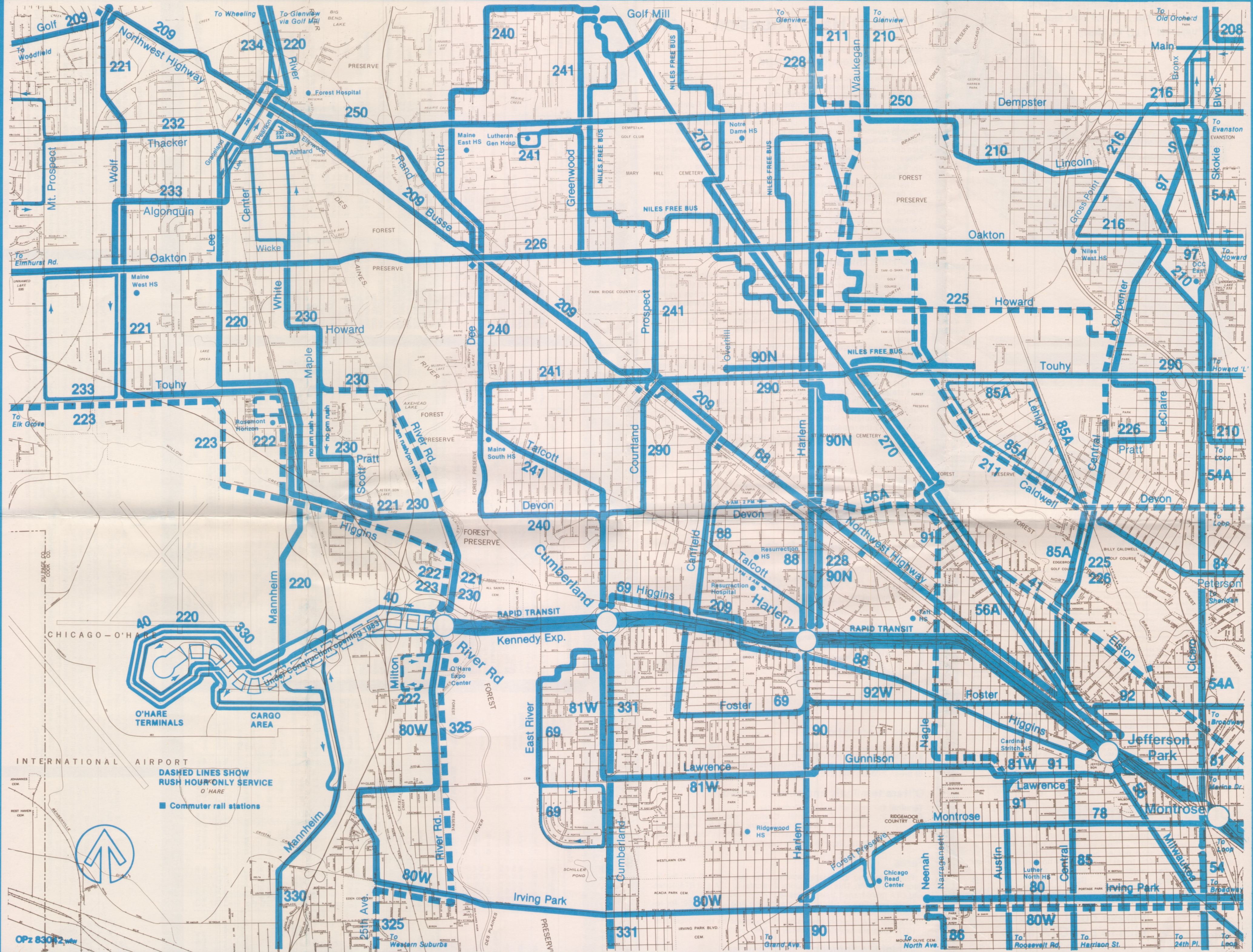

O'Hare Extension rapid transit service

On the West-Northwest rapid transit route, Congress-Milwaukee trains operate between River Road (5800 N-9400 W) and Desplaines Avenue in Forest Park (7600 W-600 S) via the Dearborn subway and Congress branch. Douglas-Milwaukee trains operate between River Road (5800 N-9400 W) and 54th Avenue in Cicero (5400 W-2100 S) via the Dearborn subway and Douglas branch.

Monday through Friday, AM thru PM rush periods, A and B trains provide express service between River Road and Lake Transfer. At all other times trains will make all stops on the route.

Coming Soon: the extension to O'Hare International Airport, at which time the Milwaukee line will be renamed the O'Hare line and River Road will become a B stop.

CTA's O'Hare Extension

Better transit service for northwestern Chicagoland

Residents of Chicago's far northwest side and nearby suburbs can now enjoy better transit service and faster commuting through the completion of the first phase of the O'Hare Extension.

Three new rapid transit stations at Harlem Avenue, Cumberland Avenue and River Road along the Kennedy Expressway extend CTA's West-Northwest rapid transit route from Jefferson Park to serve the growing residential, business, and industrial areas near O'Hare International Airport. The No. 40 O'Hare bus route now provides faster service directly to the airport from River Road station. Other CTA and RTA buses throughout the northwest area have been rerouted to provide more comprehensive service with convenient stops at the new rapid transit stations.

The modern stations were designed for efficient passenger flow and passenger safety. All three stations feature large bus boarding areas and "Kiss-N-Ride" short-term parking spaces for the convenience of riders who are driven to the stations. The Cumberland Avenue and River Road stations also feature "Park-N-Ride" lots for commuters who prefer to park all day near the stations.

"Straight-in-approach" to O'Hare this summer

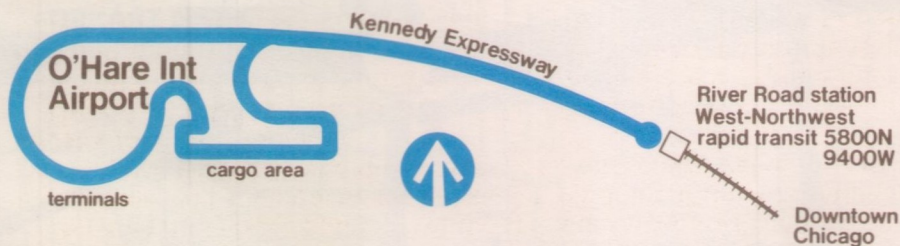
The completion of CTA's O'Hare Rapid Transit Extension this summer will provide a "straight-in-approach" to O'Hare International Airport with direct transfer to CTA's entire rapid transit and bus system and RTA suburban buses. Airline passengers and airport workers will enjoy fast, convenient and inexpensive transit service to the airport. Estimated travel time between the Dearborn Street Subway in Downtown Chicago and the new O'Hare Subway Terminal will be 33 minutes.

The modern O'Hare Subway Terminal under the airport's main parking garage will include three tracks for efficient train movements. Passengers will use escalators, elevators, and speedwalks for easy access to airport facilities.

The 7.6 mile O'Hare Rapid Transit Extension from CTA's Jefferson Park station on the West-Northwest rapid transit route to O'Hare International Airport is being built by the City of Chicago, Department of Public Works, at a cost of approximately \$180 million. The U.S. Urban Mass Transportation Administration is providing 80 per cent of the funding, and the remaining 20 per cent of the funding is being provided by the Illinois Department of Transportation and the City of Chicago.

No. 40 O'Hare bus

CTA's No. 40 O'Hare bus route now serves O'Hare International Airport Terminals 1, 2, and 3, and various stops in the cargo area, direct from the River Road station of the O'Hare Extension (West-Northwest rapid transit route).



Hours of operation

O'Hare buses leave the River Road station every day of the week, every 12-15 minutes from 4:30 am to 11:00 pm, and every half hour at all other times, except that no O'Hare buses leave River Road station between 2:06 am and 3:06 am.

- Terminal 1:** International and Commuter

Fares

When boarding at O'Hare Terminals the fare is \$1.00 (50¢ for reduced fare riders). This fare includes a transfer to CTA and RTA buses and CTA rapid transit trains if desired.

When boarding at River Road station the fare is \$1.00 (50¢ for reduced fare riders) or a valid CTA or RTA transfer.

CTA and RTA monthly passes are also honored on the O'Hare bus. (CTA fares are explained in detail on back cover.)

"Straight-in-approach" this summer

When the O'Hare Extension is completed this summer, CTA rapid transit trains on the West-Northwest rapid transit route will continue past the River Road station for a "straight-in-approach" to O'Hare International Airport at the new O'Hare Subway Terminal under the main parking garage. Escalators, elevators, and speedwalks will provide easy entry to the terminal area.

Three new rapid transit stations along the Kennedy/O'Hare Extension route were dedicated in memory of three Chicago police officers killed in the line of duty. Mayor Jane M. Byrne named the stations in honor of the officers while presiding at dedication ceremonies.

Officer Richard J. O'Brien

October 20, 1948 - February 9, 1982

The Kennedy/Harlem rapid transit station along the O'Hare Extension was dedicated October 20, 1982, in memory of Officer Richard J. O'Brien, a veteran of nearly nine years service with the Chicago Police Department.
Officer O'Brien received his appointment to the Chicago Police Department on March 19, 1973, and was fatally wounded in the line of duty on February 9, 1982. Subsequently, he was the posthumous recipient of the Superintendent's Award of Valor, and the Police Blue Star Award for heroism and devotion to duty. Officer O'Brien is survived by his mother, Mrs. LaVergne O'Brien.
O'Brien was born in Chicago on October 20, 1948. He attended Dawes Grammar School, St. Laurence High School, and DePaul University.

Officer James E. Doyle

December 2, 1947 - February 5, 1982

The Kennedy/Cumberland rapid transit station was dedicated December 2, 1982, by Mayor Jane M. Byrne in memory of Officer James E. Doyle, a policeman for eight months.
Officer Doyle was appointed to the Chicago Police Department in June 1981, and was mortally wounded by gun shots on February 5, 1982, as he attempted to arrest a robbery suspect.
In recognition of his bravery and devotion to duty, Officer Doyle received posthumously the Superintendent's Award of Valor and the Police Blue Star Award. He is survived by his mother, Mrs. Rose Doyle, and a sister, Mary Jo.
Born in Chicago on December 2, 1947, James E. Doyle was a graduate of St. Denis Elementary School and Bogan High School. He served with distinction in Viet Nam as a member of the U.S. Army where he earned the Viet Nam Service and Campaign Medals.

Officer Martin E. Darcy, Jr.

September 5, 1930 - September 27, 1982

The Kennedy/River Road rapid transit station along the O'Hare Extension was dedicated on December 7, 1982, by Mayor Jane M. Byrne in memory of Officer Martin Emmett Darcy, Jr., a policeman for 27 years.
Appointed to the Chicago Police Department on August 22, 1955, Officer Darcy earned 11 citations for Honorable Mention, and numerous letters of appreciation. He died of gun shot wounds sustained September 27, 1982, in the line of duty as he attempted to make an arrest. Officer Darcy has also been nominated to receive the Superintendent's Award of Valor and the Police Blue Star Award for heroism.
He was born in Joliet on September 5, 1930, and attended St. Brendan's Elementary School and Holy Trinity High School in Chicago. He was honorably discharged after serving in the U.S. Army from November 5, 1951, to October 8, 1953.
Officer Darcy is survived by his wife, Patricia, three daughters, a son and a brother.

Transfer is also valid on designated RTA suburban bus routes.
