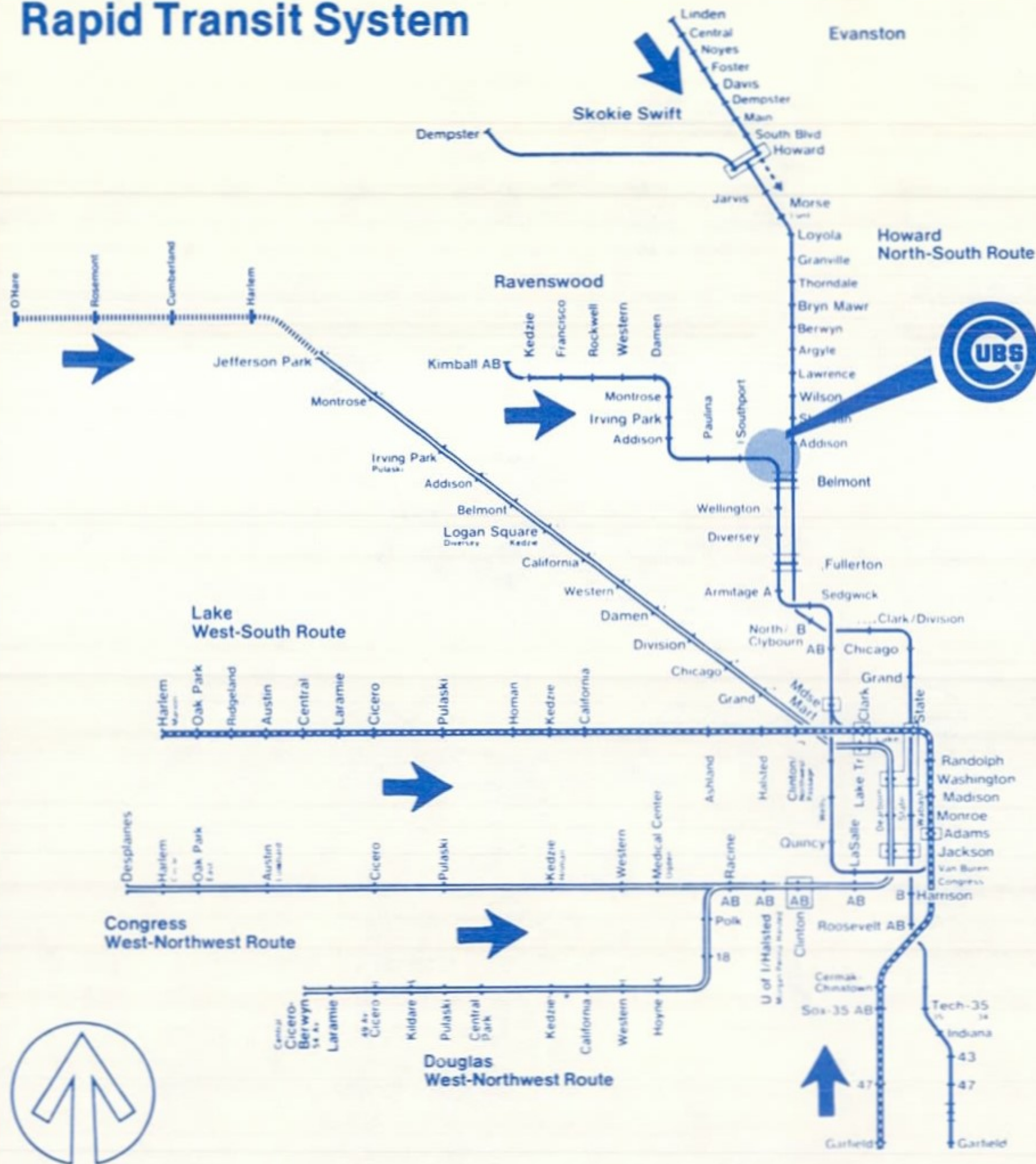

# Rapid Transit System



The CTA is the way to go to see the Chicago Cubs play ball at Wrigley Field.

Wrigley Field is a fast pitch away from the Addison station on the Howard-Englewood-Jackson Park 'L' - subway route. Both 'A' and 'B' trains stop at the Addison station for the games.

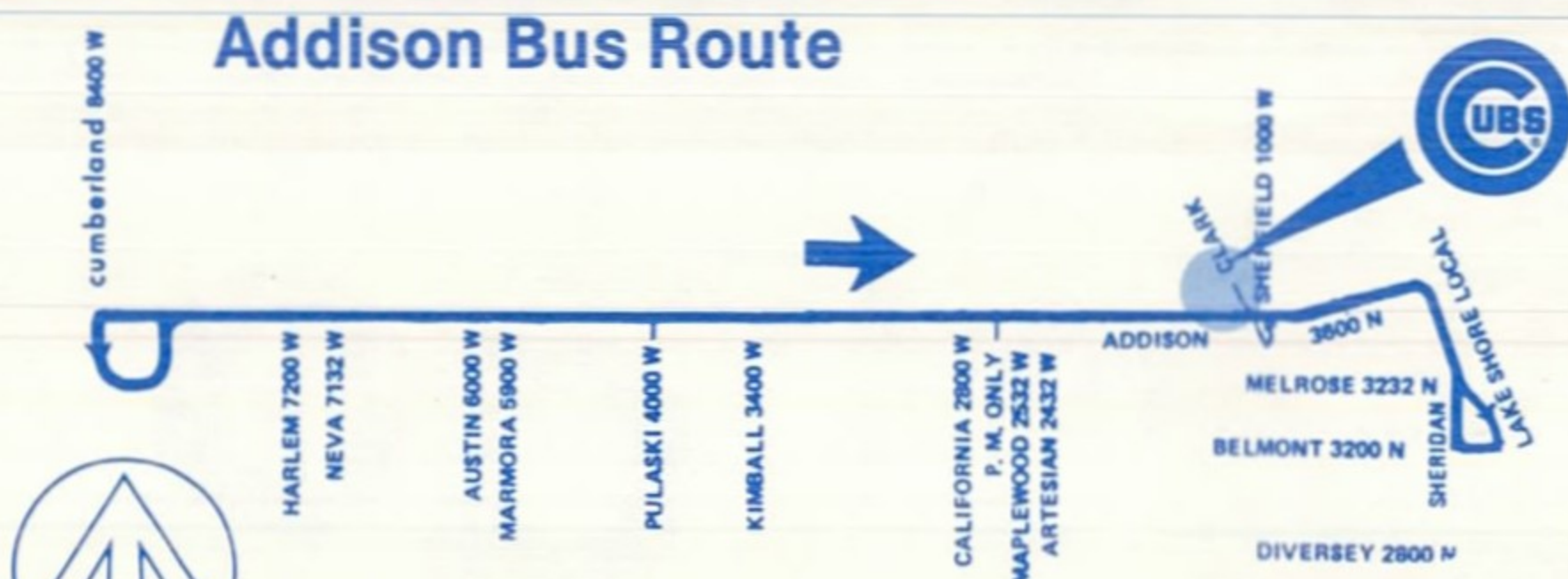
In the downtown area, trains operate in the State Street subway. On the north side, trains originate at Howard Street, where connections may be made with Skokie Swift and Evanston trains. On the south side, trains originate at either 63rd and Ashland (Englewood) or 63rd and University (Jackson Park).

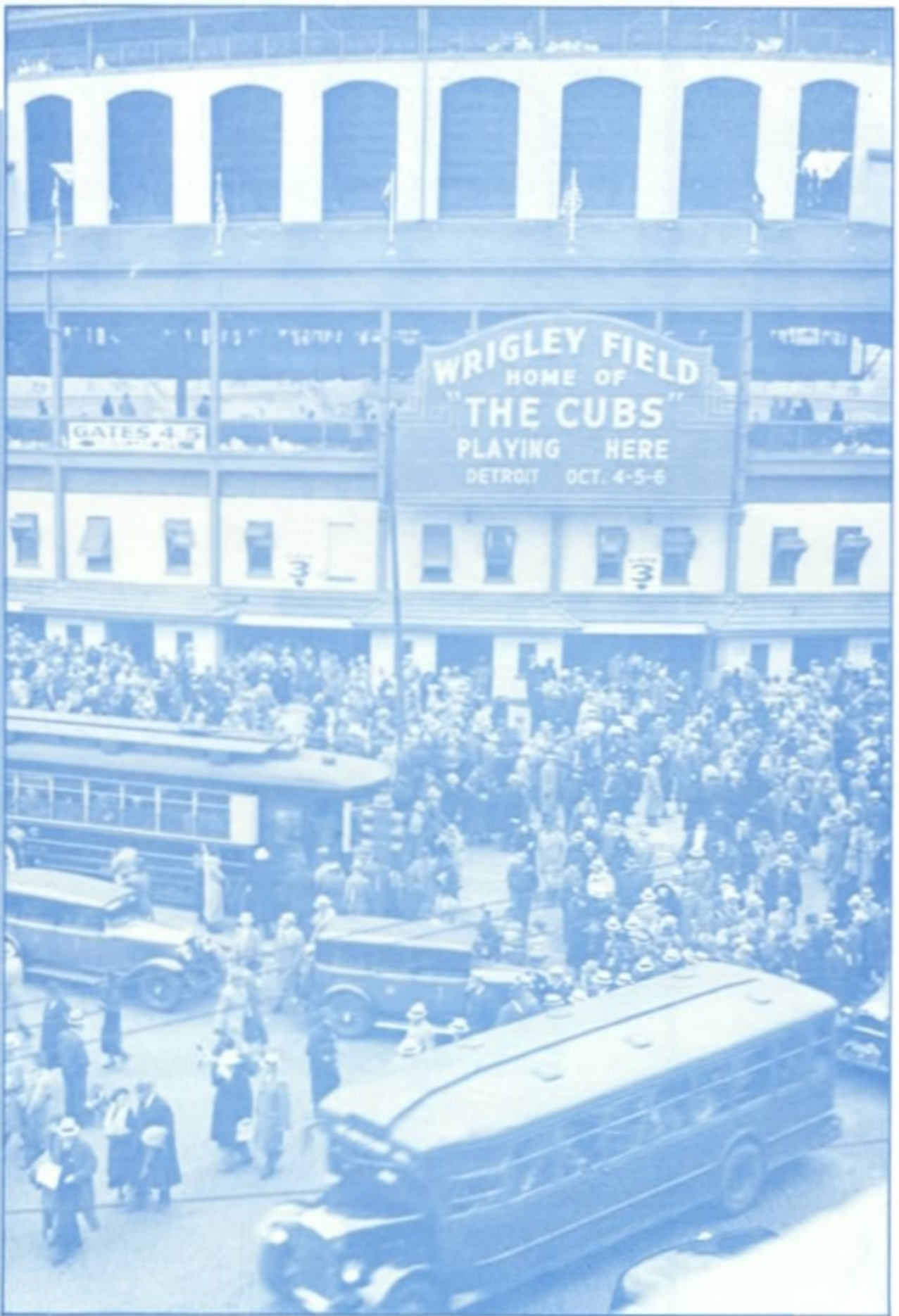
Bus service to the park is provided by the No. 152 Addison route or the No. 22 Clark route. Easy transfers from other routes may be made from intersecting north-south or east-west bus routes.

From O'Hare International airport, where CTA recently opened a rapid transit terminal directly under the parking garage, you can take an O'Hare-Douglas 'B' train to the Addison station. At Addison, you can transfer to an eastbound No. 152 Addison bus for a direct trip to the ball park.

The CTA fare is 90 cents and an extra 10 cents if a transfer is needed. For children 7 through 11, the fare is 40 cents, plus 10 cents for a transfer.
