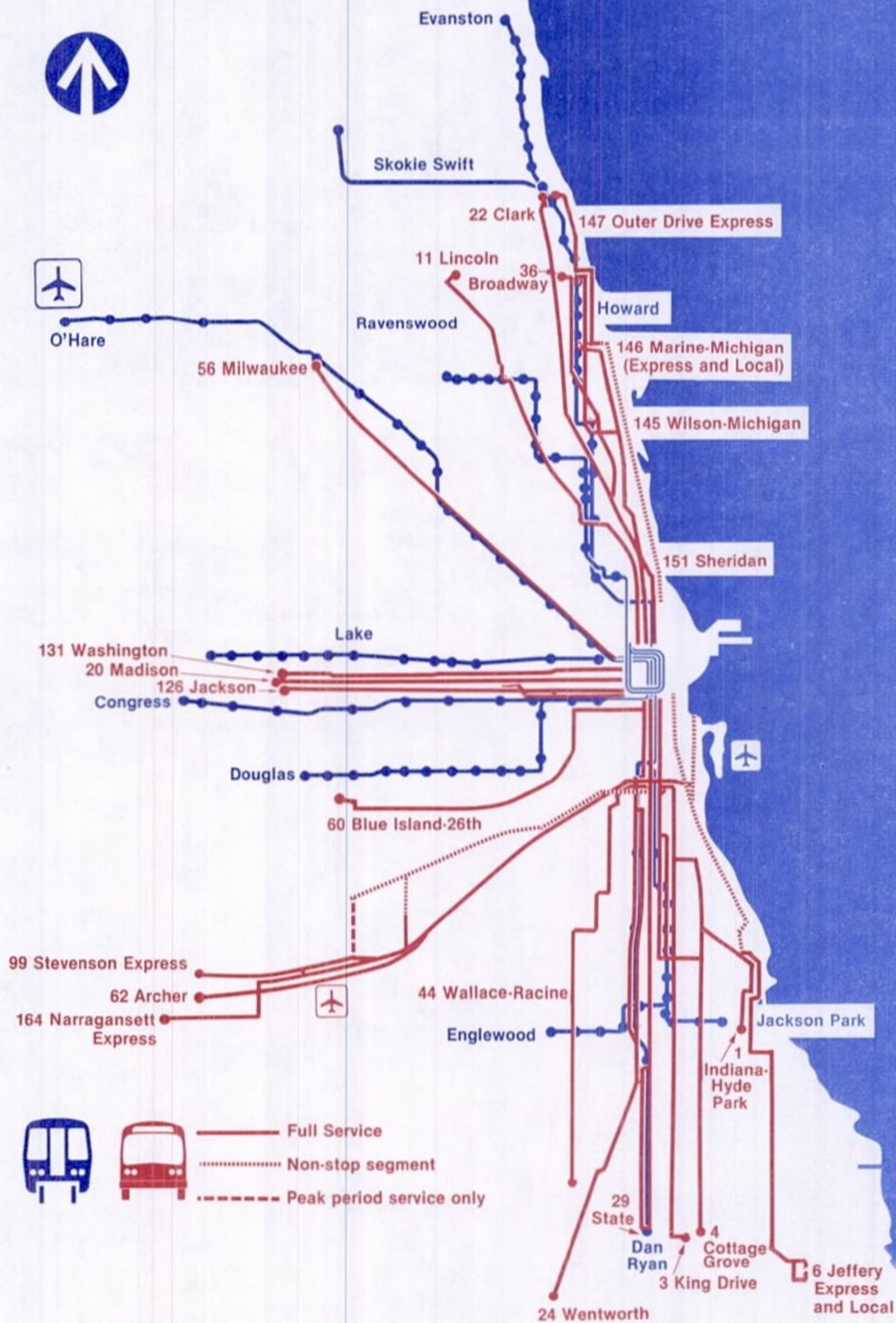




# ***cta's the way to State Street Mall***





You can enjoy an exciting variety of shopping, entertainment, and dining right in the heart of Chicago's Loop along the State Street Mall.

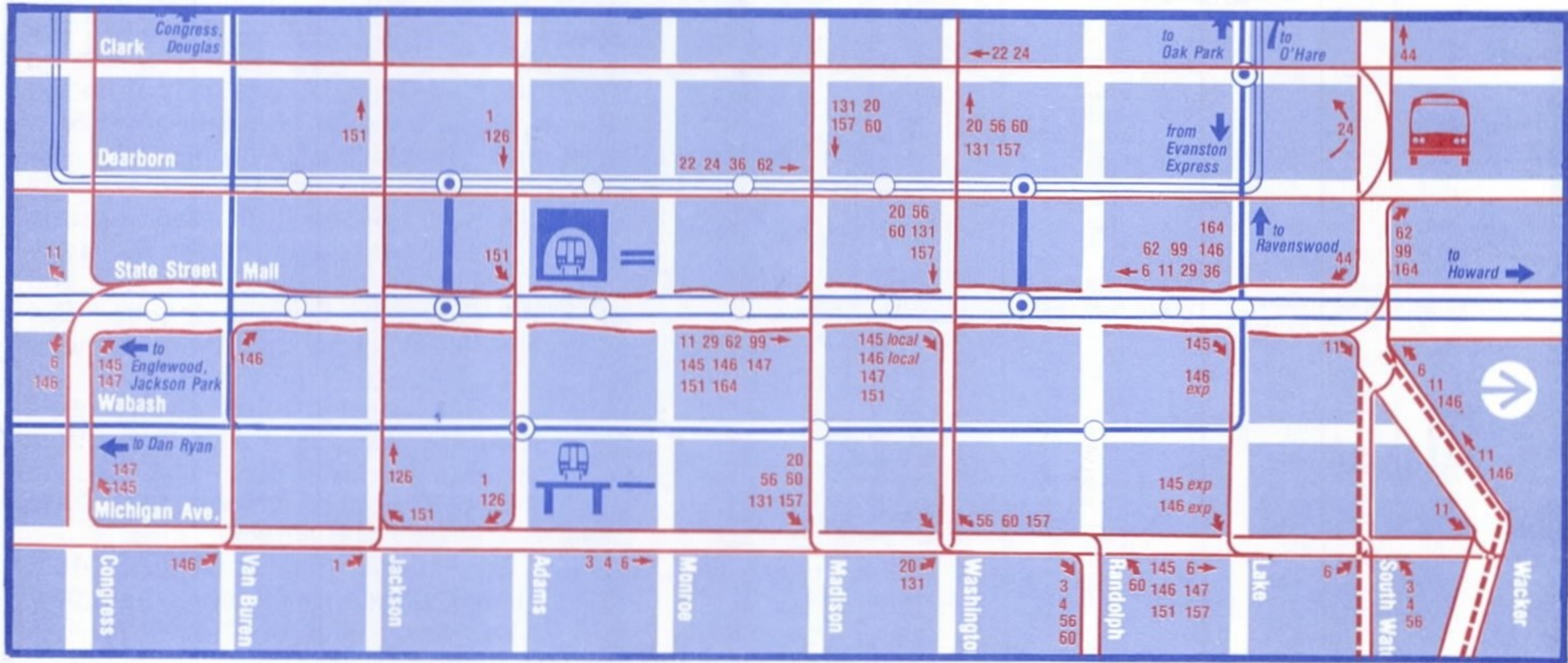
The treasures of the world await you at the Loop's department stores, specialty stores, and gift shops. Movie houses, theaters, cultural attractions, and other points of interest are just steps away. And food for every taste and pocketbook may be found at the many fine restaurants and snack shops throughout the area.

All of these attractions are along the State Street Mall or within easy walking distance — and CTA is your best way to get there. Rapid transit lines and bus routes from throughout the city converge in the Loop area, and the State Street Mall is reserved for the exclusive use of CTA buses.

By taking CTA, you can avoid the expense and aggravation of driving and parking. CTA fare to or from the Loop is only 90¢ (40¢ senior citizens and disabled with proper RTA I.D. card and children 7 through 11), plus 10¢ for a transfer, if needed. (Certain express bus routes require 20¢ additional upon boarding outbound, and the Evanston Express requires 20¢ additional upon boarding inbound from Evanston.)

The map at the left shows rapid transit routes and major bus routes serving the Loop area. The map on the back cover shows the State Street Mall and adjacent streets.
