

Attention SOUTHBOUND Englewood and Jackson Park riders during late night and early morning hours

Change in service due to construction work
 Monday, November 12, 1984 through
 Friday, November 16, 1984

Due to repair work on the southbound State Street subway tracks starting Monday night, November 29, 1984, southbound Englewood and Jackson Park trains will be temporarily rerouted between FULLERTON and TECH-35TH from the normal subway route to a routing over the Loop 11. In downtown, trains will stop at CLARK/LAKE, STATE/LAKE, RANDOLPH/WABASH and ADAMS/WABASH.

The reroute will be in effect during the following hours (approximate):

11:00 pm - 5:00 am Monday thru Friday nights

A shuttle train will be operated southbound from Belmont to Washington for passengers traveling to points in the subway. The shuttle will operate every 30 minutes.

Destination: Passengers should:

Clark/Division Chicago/State Grand/State	Change at Belmont to shuttle train
Washington/State	Take regular train to State/Lake on Loop 'L' or change at Belmont to shuttle train
Monroe/State Jackson/State	Take regular train to Adams/Wabash Loop 'L' station
Roosevelt/State	Take regular train to State/Lake on Loop 'L' and transfer to the #29 State bus
All other destinations	Use regular service

Boarding at: Southbound passengers should:

Washington/State Monroe/State Jackson/State	Board regular Englewood or Jackson Park train at closest Loop 'L' station.
Roosevelt/State	Take #29 State bus to Tech-35th and transfer to regular train.

Regular northbound service will be operated and will NOT be affected during this southbound rerouting.
