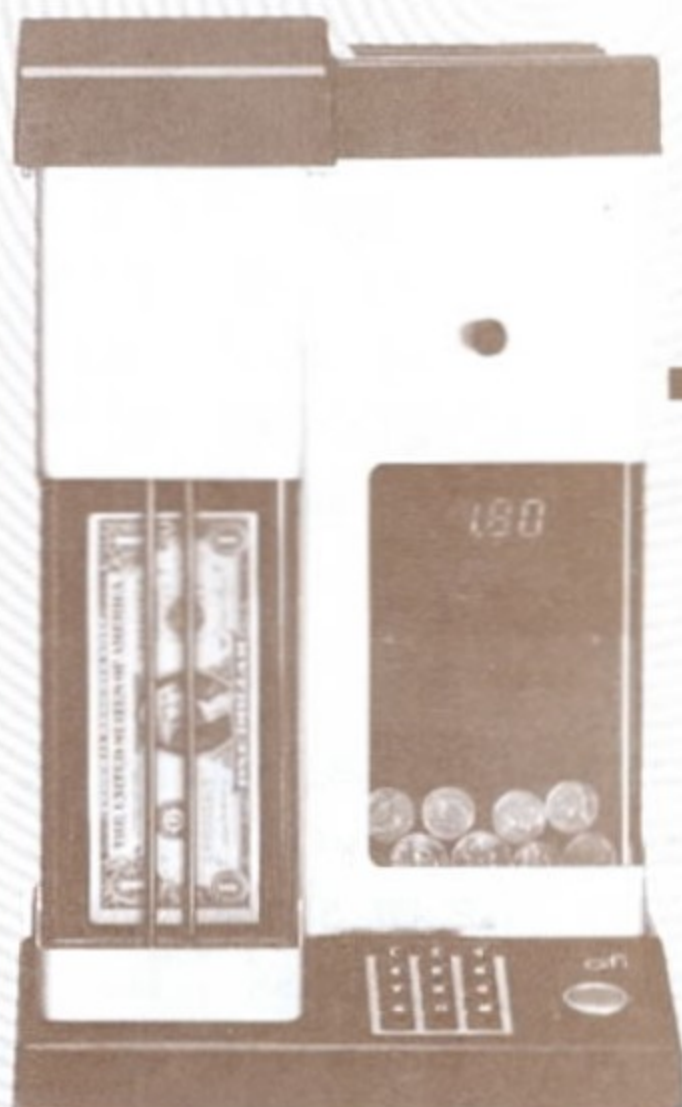

REMEMBER:

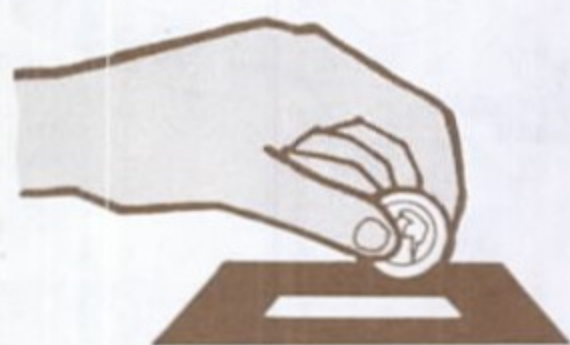
Have the exact

HOW YOU CAN HELP US TO SERVE YOU BETTER:

EXACT FARE, PLEASE!



Have your fare ready to insert into the farebox when you board the bus.



Insert **only coins** and **tokens** into the coin slot. Do not insert dollar bills, passes, or transfers in coin slot.



If you are paying with a dollar bill, open it full length and insert it into the bill slot. Do not insert coins, passes, or transfers in bill slot.



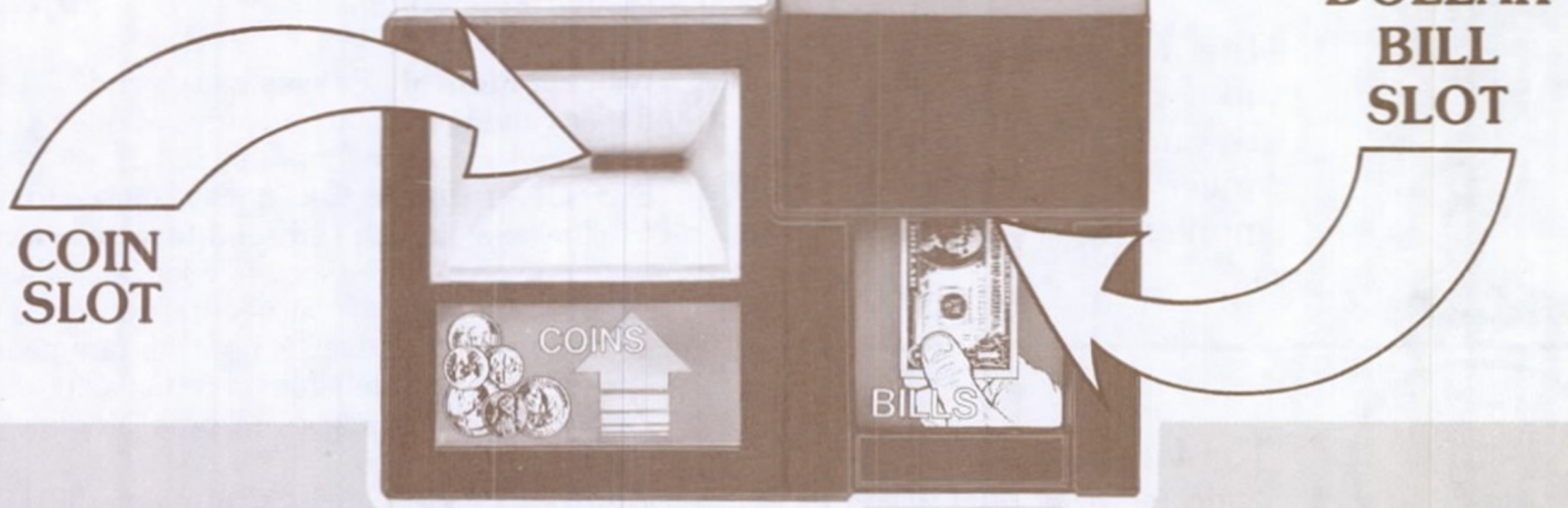
Listen for the “**BEEP!**” sound after you pay your fare or show the driver your pass. The farebox will sound a “**BEEP!**” which tells you and the driver that the correct fare has been paid. It's our way of saying thank you.



Please insert all fares into the farebox. Drivers are not permitted to accept your fares.

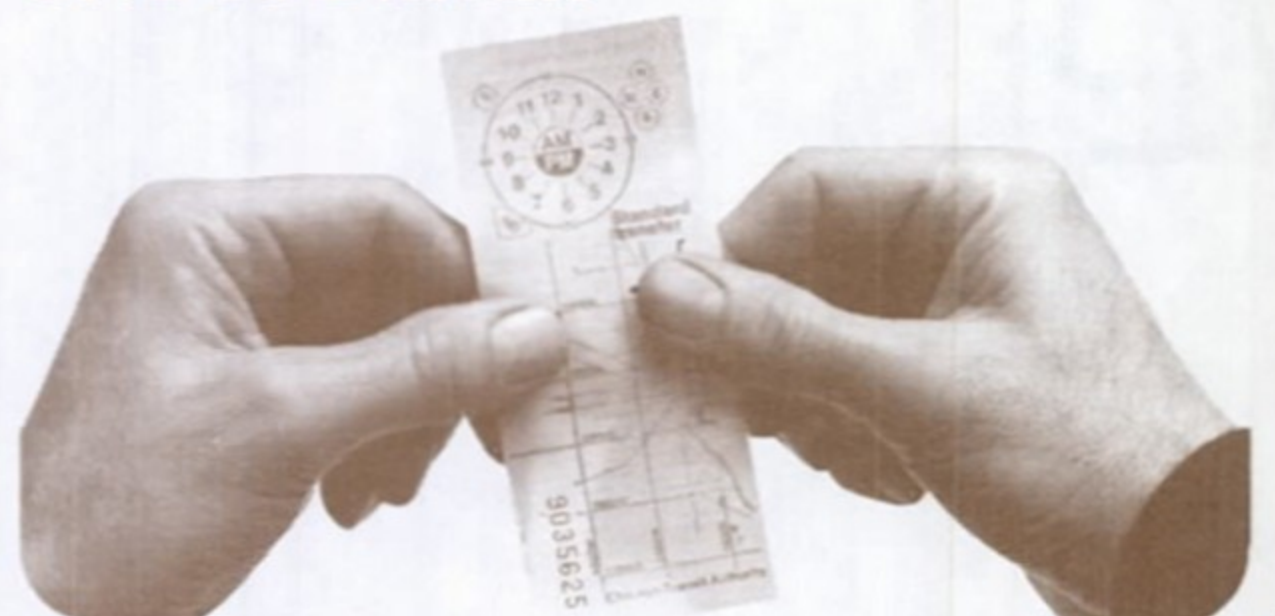

HOW THIS NEW SYSTEM WILL HELP US SERVE YOU BETTER:

The new farebox speeds up the counting of fares. The machine — not the driver — counts the money.

2

The farebox counts various types of payments to provide operational information for improving your service.

3

The farebox accepts all **U.S. coins** and **one dollar bills** for the payment of your fare.

4

The farebox is CTA's way of improving service to you.

SAVE MONEY AND TIME WITH CTA MONTHLY PASSES AND TOKENS

CTA Monthly Pass	\$40.00
Special Users Monthly Pass *	\$18.00
Full-Fare Tokens	10 for \$8.50
Reduced-Fare Tokens *	20 for \$8.00

With our **Monthly Passes** you can ride CTA buses and trains and RTA suburban buses as often and as far as you like for one low monthly fare.

Each CTA **full-fare token** may be used to pay one 90¢ full fare, and each **reduced-fare token** may be used to pay one 40¢ reduced fare for Special Users. A 10¢ transfer charge, if you need a transfer, must be paid at the time the token is used for fare payment.

The 20¢ express surcharge on certain express routes in certain directions applies to both Monthly Passes and tokens.

Monthly Passes are sold at over 400 locations throughout Chicago and the suburbs, including CTA bus garages and terminals, CTA Cashier (7th Floor, Merchandise Mart), currency exchanges, banks, savings and loans, and other businesses. For further information call **664-7200, ext. 3399**.

Full-fare tokens are sold at CTA locations as listed above, Jewel and Dominick's Food Stores, and many currency exchanges. **Reduced-fare tokens** are sold at CTA locations as listed above, some Jewel and Dominick's Food Stores, and many currency exchanges.

CTA rapid transit ticket agents sell full-fare tokens only.
