To help guess the number of riders FROM the CTA rapid transit station at O'Hare, here is some background information: The CTA-O'Hare rapid transit station opened on September 3, 1984, and has been praised as the most convenient and economical way to get to and from O'Hare International Airport. On May 29, 1985, the CTA-O'Hare station celebrated its One Millionth Passenger. Approximately 4-5,000 riders use the CTA service FROM O'Hare on weekdays and Sundays, and approximately 3-4,000 use this service on Saturdays.
