WEEKEND CLOSINGS FOR RENOVATION

MARCH 30 -SEPTEMBER 2, 1991



On weekends from March 30 through September 2 (except June 29-30 for the Taste of Chicago), the State Street subway will be closed for track replacement.


Howard-Englewood-Jackson Park trains will be **REROUTED** over the elevated route between the Fullerton and Tech-35th stations.

This is the first major track replacement work done in the State Street subway since it opened in 1943. In addition, stations will be repainted, light fixtures cleaned, various repairs made, and the tunnel walls in station areas painted for a bright, new look.

All of this is part of a multi-million dollar upgrading of CTA's most heavily-traveled rail route.

THERE ARE FOUR MAJOR THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW:

- 1. What stations are closed
- 2. Where rerouted trains will be running (and stopping)
- 3. How to get to rerouted trains from closed stations
- 4. How to transfer to/from Dearborn subway trains downtown

The North/Clybourn and Harrison/State stations are already closed on weekends, so they are not affected by this project.

WHERE THE TRAINS WILL BE RUNNING (AND STOPPING)

Howard-Englewood-Jackson Park trains will detour over the elevated route in both directions between Fullerton and Tech-35th stations, between 1:15am Saturday and 4:30am Monday.

Trains will make these stops at all times the detour is in effect:

Chicago/Franklin State/Lake

Merchandise Mart Randolph/Wabash

Clark/Lake Madison/Wabash

Adams/Wabash

★ In addition, trains will **ALSO** stop at the following stations on **SUNDAYS ONLY**, between 6:00am and 8:30pm:

Wellington

Diversey

Armitage

Sedgwick

HOW TO GET TO TRAINS FROM CLOSED STATIONS

Roosevelt/State Station Users:

- For northbound trains, take the 29 State or 62 Archer buses north to downtown and board trains at elevated stations above Wabash or Lake streets. Please purchase a transfer from the bus operator to use at elevated stations.
- For southbound trains, take the **29 State** bus south to 35th Street and board trains at Tech-35th station. *Please purchase a transfer from the bus operator to use at the elevated station.*

Jackson/State and Monroe/State Station Users:

 Board trains at the Adams/Wabash or Madison/Wabash elevated stations.

For northbound trains, go to the Lake/ Ravenswood (northbound) platform. For southbound trains, go to the Dan Ryan (southbound) platform.

Washington/State Station Users:

 Board trains at the Randolph/Wabash or State/Lake elevated stations.

For northbound trains, go to the Lake/ Ravenswood (northbound) platform. For southbound trains, go to the Dan Ryan (southbound) platform. NOTE: The Pedway (upper level walkway) between the Washington/Dearborn subway station, Marshall Field's, and the Metra Randolph St. station will remain open, but there will be NO ACCESS to the State Street subway.

Grand/State Station Users:

• Take the **29 State** or **36 Broadway** buses south on State to the State/Lake elevated station. *Please purchase a transfer from the bus operator to use at the elevated station.*

For northbound trains, go to the Lake/ Ravenswood (northbound) platform. For southbound trains, go to the Dan Ryan (southbound) platform.

Chicago/State Station Users:

• Take the **66 Chicago bus** west to the Chicago/Franklin elevated station. *Please purchase a transfer from the bus operator to use at the elevated station.*

Clark/Division Station Users:

- For northbound trains, take nonstop shuttle bus (from northwest corner) to Fullerton station. Bus leaves every 7 minutes all day and evening, and every 15 minutes overnight. Please purchase transfer from bus operator to use at Fullerton station.
- For southbound trains, take the 22 Clark or 36 Broadway buses south to Clark/ Lake or State/Lake elevated stations downtown. Please purchase a transfer from bus operator to use at the elevated station. Board trains on the Dan Ryan (southbound) platform.

Leave Howard-Englewood-Jackson Park trains at Clark/Lake, or Congress-Douglas-O'Hare trains at Lake Transfer.

Free transfers between the Clark/Lake elevated station and the Lake Transfer subway station (in the State of Illinois Center) will be issued by ticket agents at both stations while the State Street subway is closed.

NOTE: Between 10:00pm and 6:00am, there will be no ticket agent at the Clark/Lake (northbound - Outer Loop) platform to give out free "L to Subway" transfers.

To obtain this transfer, cross over to the other platform (southbound - Inner Loop) by using the overhead walkway bridge. Obtain the free "L to Subway" transfer from the ticket agent on this southbound platform.
