The Chicago Transit Authority's Culture Bus is a great way to discover our city's *HOT* museums, *COOL* neighborhoods, and *FUN* spots.

A commentator on each bus tells you about Chicago's history and points of interest along the routes. Buses run Sundays and Holidays from May 12 to September 29.

4 good reasons to ride with us:

1. We're easy to use. No reservations are needed. Just come down to the Art Institute (on Michigan at Adams) or any one of our stops and board our air-conditioned buses!

2. We're convenient. Buses run every half hour on 3 different routes, taking you to over 30 attractions and areas. There's something for everyone—of all ages!

3. We're flexible. Ride one route or all of them, and make as many or as few stops as you like—and stay as long as you like at any one place. You never have to "go with the crowd."

4. We're economical. You get unlimited riding all day for just \$2.50 for adults and \$1.25 for children ages 7-11. The ticket also gives you discounts at several attractions (marked with *).

Culture Bus Fares

- Each ticket is good for travel **all day** on **Culture Buses only**.
- Exact fare is required, but dollar bills **can be used**.
- CTA tokens **cannot be used** on Culture Bus.

Reduced fare rider*	1.25
Adult with transfer	1.00
Reduced with transfer*40
Adult or reduced monthly pass** ...	No charge
Children age 6 or younger.....	No charge

* Children 7-11 years old; seniors 65 and older with RTA card, and disabled with RTA card.

** Weekday monthly passes are only valid on Memorial Day, 4th of July, and Labor Day.
