



#130 GRANT PARK TREASURES BUS

Direct service from LaSalle Station to Art Institute, Field Museum, Shedd Aquarium, and Adler Planetarium. Operates weekends during spring and summer through Labor Day weekend. Every 15 minutes from 9:40 a.m. (10:40 a.m. Sundays/Holidays) to 5:55 p.m.

METRA FARE BARGAINS

LINK-UP STICKER—For just \$36 monthly, Metra monthly ticket holders get unlimited riding on CTA and most Pace suburban buses. Buy a Link-Up sticker when you buy your Metra monthly ticket at the station or by mail.

\$5.00 WEEKEND PASS—Unlimited rides on both Saturday and Sunday. Can be used in combination with Family Fares. (Not applicable on Chicago South Shore and South Bend).

FAMILY FARES—Available on weekends and selected holidays. Children under 12 ride free when accompanied by a fare paying adult (up to three children free per adult). Ages 12-17 ride for half price. Monthly, weekly, or 10-ride tickets or the weekend pass. may be used for the adult fare.

GROUP TRAVEL—Greatly discounted fares for groups of 25 or more during off-peak hours and weekends. Call Metra at 312-322-6772.
