

Transfer Card







A Transfer Card costs 30¢ (15¢ for reduced fare rides), and allows passengers two additional rides on other bus or train routes within two hours of purchase.



### **Getting The Card**

At each station, only ONE turnstile issues full fare **Transfer Cards**. Look for this sign:

\$1.80 (exact full fare, including transfer charge). Use coins or full fare tokens. The turnstiles do not accept pennies.

After a beep, a **Transfer Card** will "pop-up" from the top of the turnstile, just ahead of where you deposited your fare. The LED display shows the fare paid.

Take the card and go through.

### **Using The Card**


Use the **Transfer Card** in any turnstile with a U-shaped bar over it, or give it to a station agent.

Insert the **Transfer Card** into slot on top of the turnstile, with the front of the card facing you.

The machine will "grab" the card, read it, and "pop" it back up to you.

Take it, and then go through. The turnstile will not unlock until you remove the card from the slot.

# ATTRAIN STATIONS



#### Tracking Rides

The first time you use the card, the LED display will read:

#### THANK YOU T 1 PLEASE ENTER

On the back of the card, the number "1" will appear to the left of the expiration time, indicating the card is valid for one more ride.

The second time you use the card, the LED display will read:

#### THANK YOU TØ PLEASE ENTER

On the back of the card, "VOID" will appear twice, covering the "1 EXP", indicating no more rides are left.

Again, take the card with you


– the machine doesn't keep
expired cards. The turnstile lets
you through only after the card
is removed.

### **Getting The Card**

Deposit the exact fare, including transfer charge, into the farebox.

The operator will put a **Transfer Card** into the Farecard Machine
on the right side of the farebox.
The machine activates the card.

When the card pops up — take it!



## ONBUSES



### Using The Card

Insert **Transfer Card** into Farecard Machine, with the front of the card facing you. The machine will "grab" the card and read it.

The first time the card is used, it "pops" back up to you.

The LED display will read:

#### THANK YOU T 1

On the back of the card, a number "1" will appear to the left of the expiration time.

The second time the card is used, the voided card pops out the back of the machine to the operator.

The LED display will read:


#### THANK YOU TØ

On the back of the card, "VOID" will appear twice, covering the "1 EXP", indicating no more rides are left.

#### Checking The Value

The number of rides remaining on the **Card** can be checked without removing any rides.

Ask the bus operator to check the value before you put the Card into the Farecard Machine.



DOLLAR BILLS TRANSFER CARDS

The operator will press a special button.

Insert card into Farecard Machine.

The LED display will read:

1 TRF REMAIN

or 2 TRF REMAIN

The card is then returned to you.
