From the time you enter the CTA Rail System until you leave, it is your responsibility to closely supervise the children who travel with you.




Hold on to your children



You will see this sign posted at CTA stations to remind you.

ATTURNSTILES

ENTER



- Never leave children unattended near turnstiles and rotogates.
- Children 6 years & younger: Customer Assistant will open courtesy gate.
- Children age 7 to 11: Customer Assistant will assist with reduced fares.

EXIT



- Carry small children in your arms as you pass thru the turnstile.
- Hold bar for older children; help walk each child thru the turnstile.
- Never leave children unattended near turnstiles or rotogates.

ESCALATORS

- Hold handrail and attend children.
- Keep feet away from sides and edge of steps.
- Do not lean over the sides.
- Do not attempt to pick up fallen objects with hands.



STAIRS

- Hold handrail and attend children.
- Watch your step.
- Take one step at a time.

TRAVELING HELPFUL TIPS

- Trains are less crowded in non-rush hours.
- Allow extra time when traveling with children.
- When traveling with a stroller, fold it up before entering the fare collection area; strollers must go over or under turnstiles.
- Strollers must be folded up on trains and buses.
- Have proper fares/cards ready before entering fare collection area.

FARES FOR CHILDREN:

- FREE: 6 years and younger with a fare-paying rider.
- \$.75 fare; \$.15 transfer:7 to 11 years of age.
- \$1.50 fare; \$.30 transfer
 12 years and older (adult fare).


FLEWATORS

- Watch your step when entering or exiting.
- Most elevators are provided with an interior intercom to communicate with the CTA Control Center in case of an emergency
- These symbols are used on CTA elevator controls:

OPEN DOORS



CLOSE DOORS



ALARM



EMERGENCY STOP SWITCH



MAIN FLOOR



PLATFORMS

- Wait for trains in boarding area.
- Children should be seated on benches whenever possible.
- Do not stand closer than
 5 feet from the platform
 edge until the train has
 come to a complete stop.
- If an object falls onto the track, NEVER attempt to retrieve it yourself!
 Ask a CTA employee for assistance or call (312) 432-8030.





TRAINS

- Watch your step when boarding and alighting the train.
- Be aware that the train floor is slightly higher than the platform.
- Children should be seated whenever possible.
- Standing children should hold on to vertical bars or extension grab bars on seat backs.
- Never lean against doors.
- Do not cross from car to car.



- Do not stand between cars.
- In an emergency, follow the instructions of the crew and/or directions posted in the train.
