

Starting Monday, December 14th, CTA has a new crosstown connection for you. The X49 will provide fast, direct weekday service on Western Avenue between Berwyn Avenue on the North Side and 95th Street on the South Side.

It will have stops ONLY at major streets and CTA train lines, generally every mile to half-mile.

This service is *in addition to* the 49 Western and 49A South Western local buses.



The X49 can take you to work, to school, to shop and to play—in neighborhoods across the city. There are connections to Pace suburban buses, too. So take a ride. And think of it as a rapid transit line....without tracks.

TRANSIT CARDS

They automatically deduct your fare or transfer and can be recharged at any CTA rail station. Transit Cards can be shared by up to 7 full-fare riders.
