





The 5-day pass saves you 28% off the 1-day pass and 65% off the cash fare, which is \$1.50 for ages 12 and older.

Consider visitor passes for your children, also! Otherwise, the cash fare is 75 cents for ages 7-11; under age seven ride free.


CTA, O'Hare, and Midway Airports... We Have Great Connections!


