## TRANSIT CARD

Deducts full fares and transfers on CTA and Pace.

Insert & Remove Cards & Passes

The card can be shared by up to 7 full fare riders at once (each inserts it separately). Buy the card from vending machines at CTA stations from \$1.50 to \$91.

Put in the exact amount you want, push **VEND**, and out comes your card! For every \$10 put in, you get \$11.00 worth of rides. Recharge card for as little as 5¢.

Or, buy cards for \$10 (\$11 value) or \$20 (\$22 value) at Currency Exchanges, Jewel or Dominick's food stores, or on the Internet. Reduced Fare Transit Card packs are also available at these locations.



One ride is \$1.50 full fare and 75¢ reduced fare (ages 7-11). Seniors 65 and older, riders with disabilities and medicare card holders can *also* apply for RTA reduced fares (836-7000).

On buses, put the exact fare in coins or bills into the farebox. At train stations, one turnstile accepts the exact coin fare. The

station Customer Assistant will help kids through.



When you pay your cash fare, you can get a TRANSFER CARD that allows 2 more rides within 2 hours on any route (full fare 30 cents; ages 7-11, 15 cents). Connections between CTA train lines are free; no transfer card needed.

## BY CTA TRAIN

From this Line ---- To Merchandise Mart/Apparel Center

Blue Line ----- At Clark/Lake transfer to Brown Line

(elevated). Exit at Mart station.

Or use Lake/Wells exit at Clark/Lake

and walk 2 blocks north to Mart.

Red Line ----- At State/Lake transfer to the Brown Line

(elevated). Exit at Mart station.

Brown Line ----- Exit at Mart station.

Green Line ----- At Clark/Lake transfer to Brown Line

(elevated). Exit at Mart station.

Orange Line ---- At Clark/Lake transfer to Brown Line

(elevated). Exit at Mart station.

Purple Line ----- Exit at Mart station.

# FROM METRA TERMINALS

CTA buses and trains get you to the Mart/Apparel Center.

# **Ogilvie Transportation Center:**

125 Water Tower Express (Mon-Fri rush hours)
Board north on Canal to the Mart.

#### **Union Station**

125 Water Tower Express (Mon-Fri rush hours)
Board north on Canal to the Mart.

#### LaSalle Street Station:

Take Brown Line (Mon-Sat) or Purple Line (Mon-Fri rush hours) from LaSalle/Van Buren (elevated) station to the Mart station.

### Randolph Station:

Take Brown Line (Mon-Sat) from the Randolph/Wabash elevated station to the Mart station.
