




Planes to Trains

Avoid expensive cab rides. Avoid endless traffic jams. CTA provides frequent and convenient train service connecting both Midway and O'Hare Airports to downtown Chicago.

O'Hare Airport to Downtown – a 45 to 50 minute trip

CTA's O'Hare Station is centrally located in the airport, between Terminals 2 and 3 (under the Hilton Hotel). Follow these overhead signs to the station:



Board the Blue Line train to Downtown. The main downtown stations are in the subway at Clark/Lake, Washington/Dearborn, Monroe/Dearborn and Jackson/Dearborn.

Midway Airport to Downtown – a 30 to 35 minute trip

CTA's Midway Station is just east of the airport.

A skybridge with escalators, elevators and moving sidewalks connects the station to the airport. Follow the overhead "Trains to City" signs from the airport to the station.
