More routes. More buses. More service between downtown and South Side lakefront neighborhoods. Weekdays and weekends. During rush hours, and then some.




South Lake Shore Drive Bus Service Improvements

To better serve commuters along South Lake Shore Drive, the CTA is introducing two new express routes, making another route express, and making improvements and modifications to existing routes to provide more seating capacity and more efficient service to downtown. The express routes will enter South Lake Shore Drive from different points of entry, which will significantly improve travel time. Customers will have more options to and from downtown, including more daily and weekend service.

- New, expanded and revised daily service begins Sunday, August 31.
- New and revised weekday rush period service begins Tuesday, September 2.







Seven Express Routes to Downtown!*

Here is a brief summary:

#2 Hyde Park Express & — Weekday rush period service expanded in both directions between 60th/Cottage Grove and Navy Pier.

#X3 King Drive Express & (formerly #3L King Drive Limited &) — No changes to route or hours. The route has been renamed. It was formerly named #3L King Drive Limited &.

#X4 Cottage Grove Express & (New!) — Operates weekday rush periods in the direction of peak travel between 95th/St. Lawrence and Michigan/Chicago.

#6 Jackson Park Express & (formerly #6 Jeffery Express &)
— Operates daily from 79th/South Shore to Wacker/Michigan.

#14 Jeffery Express (formerly **#14 South Lake Shore Express**) — Expanded to operate daily in both directions, between 103rd/Stony Island and downtown, all day into late evening.

#26 South Shore Express & (New!) — Operates weekday rush period service in the direction of peak travel between 106th/Ewing and Chicago/Michigan.

#28 Stony Island Express & — Extended to operate daily between 103rd/Stony Island and Union Station. Some trips extend to the Illinois Medical District.

Local Service!

#1 Indiana/Hyde Park & — Operates weekday rush periods between 51st/Drexel and Union Station.

#4 Cottage Grove & — Operates daily between 95th/St. Lawrence and Columbus/South Water. Now travels north on Indiana and south on Michigan between 35th and Cermak at all times.

#15 Jeffery Local & (New!) — Operates daily between 103rd/Stony Island and the 47th (Red Line) station.

#47 47th & — Operates daily between Archer/Cicero and 47th/Lake Park.

#51 51st & — Operates daily between the Kedzie (Orange Line) station and the 47th (Red Line) station.

#71 71st/South Shore & — Operates daily between 112th/Torrence and the 69th (Red Line) station.

* The routes described in this brochure are a part of a 180-day experiment aimed at better matching service with customers' travel patterns and needs. The changes also correspond with job, development and population shifts over the last 20 years.

Express Routes

#2 Hyde Park Express & — Weekday Rush Periods

Buses will operate in both directions during weekday rush periods. The route has been extended south to 60th/Cottage Grove, and north to Navy Pier. Buses will operate express between 47th/Lake Park and 11th/Columbus. During the morning rush period, buses will travel via Lake Shore Drive, 57th, Stony Island, 60th, Cottage Grove, 51st, Lake Park, 47th and Lake Shore Drive. During the evening rush period, buses will travel via Lake Shore Drive, 47th, Lake Park, 51st, Cottage Grove, 60th, Stony Island, 57th and Lake Shore Drive.



#6 Jackson Park Express & (formerly #6 Jeffery Express ₺) — Daily


This route has been modified (and renamed) to provide new, daily, direct service between the South Shore area and downtown, from 4:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m. Buses will begin their trips at 79th/South Shore Drive instead of 103rd/ Stony Island and will travel via South Shore Drive, 67th and Stony Island, continuing along the present route to Wacker/Michigan. Buses will operate express between 47th/Lake Park and 11th/Columbus. The #14 service is expanded to serve customers south of 67th on Jeffery.


Service will now operate daily in both directions with expanded service hours. Buses will operate between 103rd/Stony Island and downtown.

#26 South Shore Express & (New!) — Weekday Rush Periods


To provide faster service between the Southeast Side and downtown, buses will operate in the direction of peak travel between 106th/Ewing and Chicago/Michigan, operating express on South Lake Shore Drive between 67th/Jeffery and 11th/Columbus.

#28 Stony Island Express &


The route has been extended to operate daily between 103rd/Stony Island and Union Station (downtown). Express service will operate early morning through late evening between 47th/Lake Park and 11th/Columbus. Certain rushperiod trips will extend to Congress/Paulina to serve the Illinois Medical District. For service along 47th between Lake Park and the Red Line, please use the extended #47 47th & bus route.


#1 Indiana/Hyde Park & — Weekday Rush Periods

For midday service, customers may use the Green Line or the #3 King Drive &, #4 Cottage Grove & or #29 State & buses. For service within Hyde Park, please use the new #15 Jeffery Local & route.

Fares

CASH FARE

One ride is \$1.50 full fare and 75¢ reduced fare. Reduced fares are for children ages 7-11, elementary and high school students with a CTA student riding permit, seniors 65 years and older and customers with disabilities with an RTA Reduced Fare Permit. Medicare cardholders are also eligible for this permit. For more information, call 836-7000 from any local area code.

On buses, deposit the exact fare in coins or bills into the farebox. At train stations, one turnstile accepts the exact coin fare.

When full or reduced fare is paid, a Transfer Card (full-fare transfer 30¢; reduced-fare transfer 15¢) can be purchased for two additional rides within two hours on CTA or Pace.

TRANSIT CARD

Full-fare Transit Cards can be purchased from vending machines at CTA rail stations. The card can be shared by up to seven full-fare customers (each inserts it separately). Deducts full fares and transfers on CTA and Pace.

Put in the exact amount you want on the card (\$1.50 to \$91). Push VEND for your card. Pre-valued Transit Card packs for \$10 (\$11 value) or \$20 (\$22 value) can be purchased at Currency Exchanges, select Jewel, Dominick's and Cub Foods stores, or online at www.transitchicago.com. Reduced Fare Transit Card packs are also available at these locations.

CHICAGO CARD

The Chicago Card is the smart, new way to pay. It's faster than using cash or Transit Cards. The card can be shared by up to seven full-fare customers (each touches it to the rail turnstile or farebox touchpad separately). Deducts full fares and transfers on CTA and Pace.
