
CTA now provides a direct service link for employees of the Skokie Southeast Industrial District. The #96 Lunt & route extension now takes customers to the doors of companies in the Skokie Southeast Industrial District from the Morse (Red Line) station. Service extends west of McCormick between Touhy and Howard. For convenience, the #11 Lincoln & route extension replaces #96 service on Kedzie Avenue.



Improved #93 California/Dodge & (formerly #93 North California)

Enjoy the convenience of taking one bus between West Rogers Park and downtown Evanston. The #93 California/Dodge & links the West Rogers Park community with jobs and entertainment in downtown Evanston. Service begins at the Kimball & (Brown Line) station, and extends north on California and Dodge (Evanston) to Emerson, and east to the Purple Line 'L' and Metra station at Davis &. This bus route will also serve Evanston Township High School, Levy Senior Activity Center, Swedish Covenant Hospital, North Park University and senior homes and centers along the route.

Visit Westfield Shoppingtown Old Orchard center, and restaurants and attractions in downtown Evanston and along Chicago Avenue on board the #205 Chicago/Golf &. This new route operates from the Howard 'L' station to the Cook County 2nd Municipal District Courthouse. This route also serves many locations including Evanston Township High School, Niles North High School, Rush North Shore Medical Center, Jewel-Osco, Dominick's (Gateway Center), Presbyterian Homes and Hill Arboretum Apartments.

During rush hours, certain trips operate on Grant to accommodate Evanston High School students and shift changes at the Swedish Retirement Center and the Presbyterian Homes.



New Route #200 Main Shuttle & (formerly #202 Main/Emerson)

CTA designed the #200 Main Shuttle & to link customers to the Purple Line 'L' and Metra stations on Main Street. Customers now have direct access to Main Street Commons Shopping Center and Rand McNally Headquarters. This route replaces the #202 Main/Emerson route. Please board the #93 California/Dodge & (formerly #93 North California) bus for service along Dodge or Emerson or to reach the Davis & (Purple Line) station.



New Route #206 Evanston Circulator &

A new rush hour only route, the #206 Evanston Circulator & provides service every 15 minutes between the Howard 'L' station and Central/Crawford. Buses travel north on Ridge and south on Dodge during morning rush hours, reverse in the evening. This route serves both St. Francis Hospital and Evanston Township High School from the Howard 'L' station in the mornings and to the station in the afternoons. This route also serves the Dominick's at Howard and at Dempster.

Fares

CASH FARE

One ride is \$1.50 full fare and 75¢ reduced fare. Reduced fares are for children ages 7-11, elementary and high school students with a CTA student riding permit, and seniors 65 years and older and customers with disabilities with an RTA Reduced Fare Permit. Medicare cardholders are also eligible for this permit. For more information, call 836-7000 from any local area code.

On buses, deposit the exact fare in coins or bills into the farebox. At train stations, one turnstile accepts the exact coin fare. The station Customer Assistant will help children through the turnstile.

When full or reduced fare is paid, a Transfer Card (full-fare transfer 30¢; reduced-fare transfer 15¢) can be purchased for two or more rides within two hours on CTA or Pace.

TRANSIT CARD

Deducts full fares and transfers on CTA and Pace.

Full-fare Transit Cards can be purchased from vending machines at CTA rail stations. The card can be shared by up to seven full-fare customers at once (each inserts it separately).

Put in the exact amount you want on the card (\$1.50 to \$91). Push VEND for your card!

Pre-valued Transit Card packs for \$10 (\$11 value) or \$20 (\$22 value) can be purchased at Currency Exchanges, select Jewel, Dominick's and Cub Foods stores, or online at www.transitchicago.com. Reduced Fare Transit Card packs are also available at these locations.

CHICAGO CARD.

The Chicago Card is the smart, new way to pay. It's faster than using cash or Transit Cards. The card can be shared by up to seven full-fare customers at once (each touches it to the rail turnstile separately). Deducts full fares and transfers on CTA and Pace.


