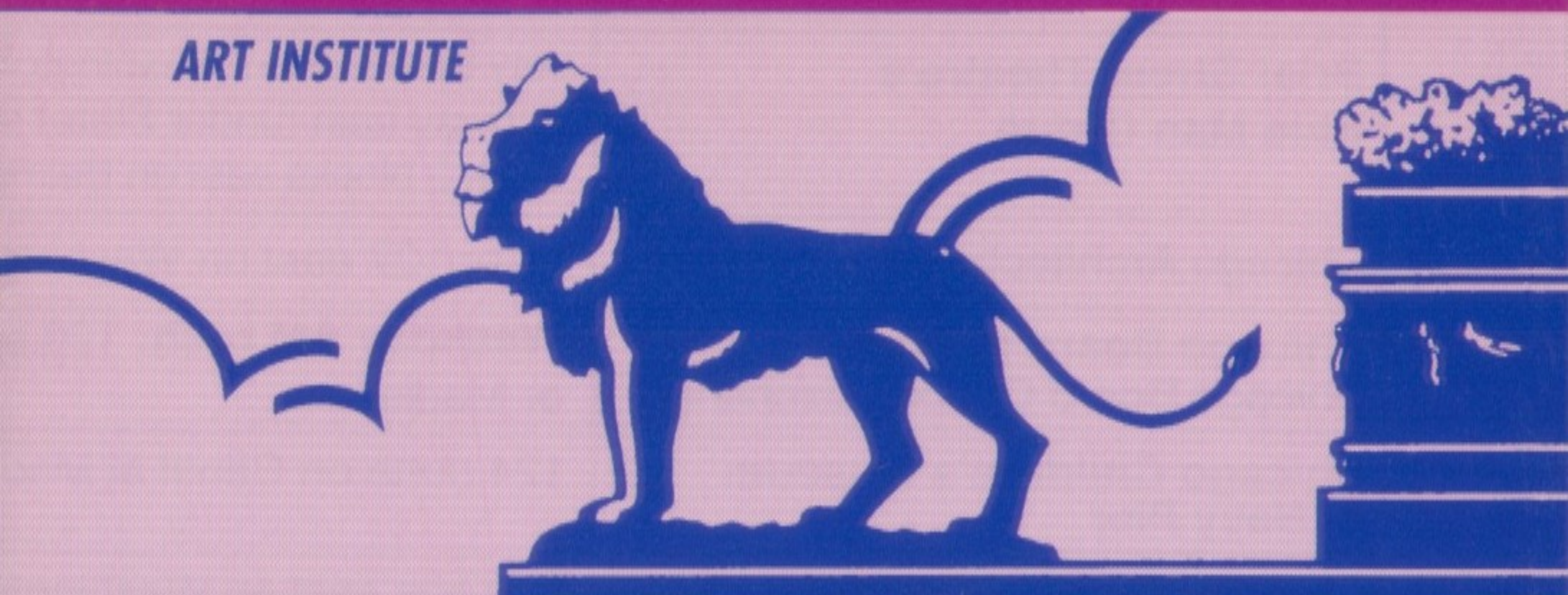

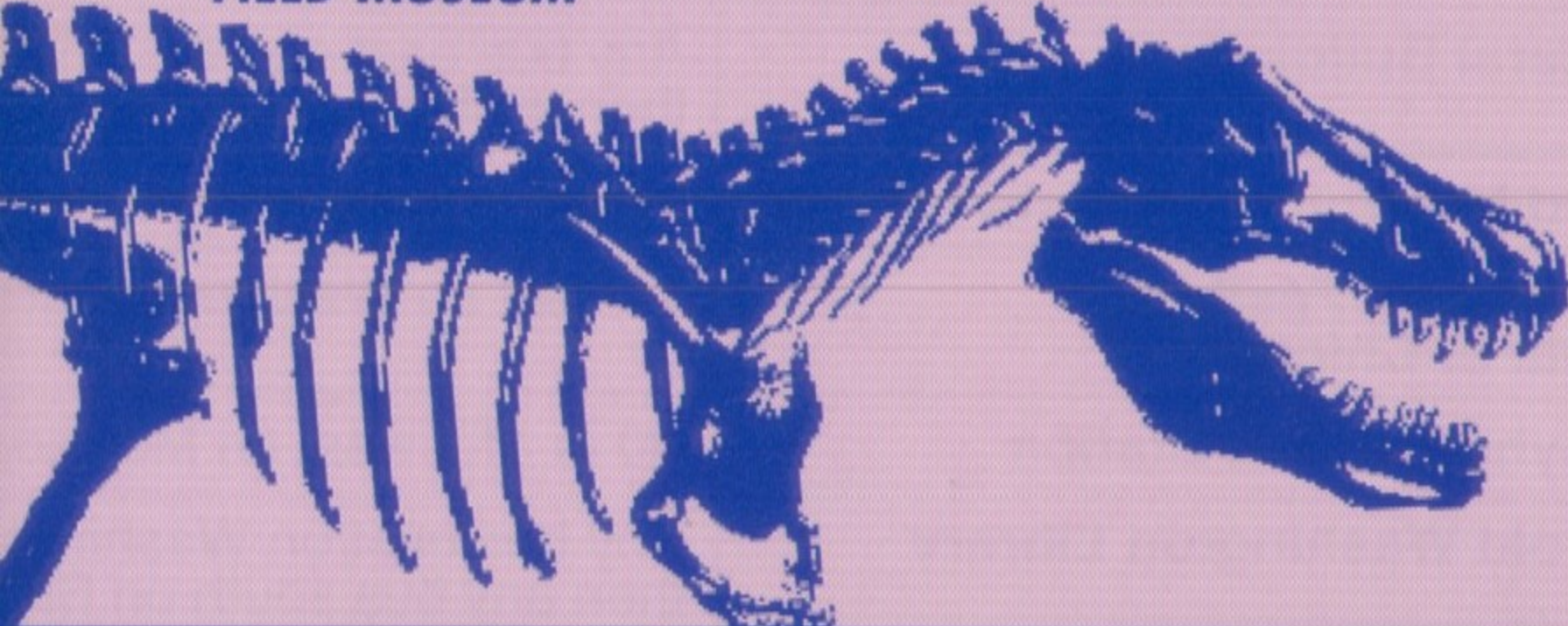

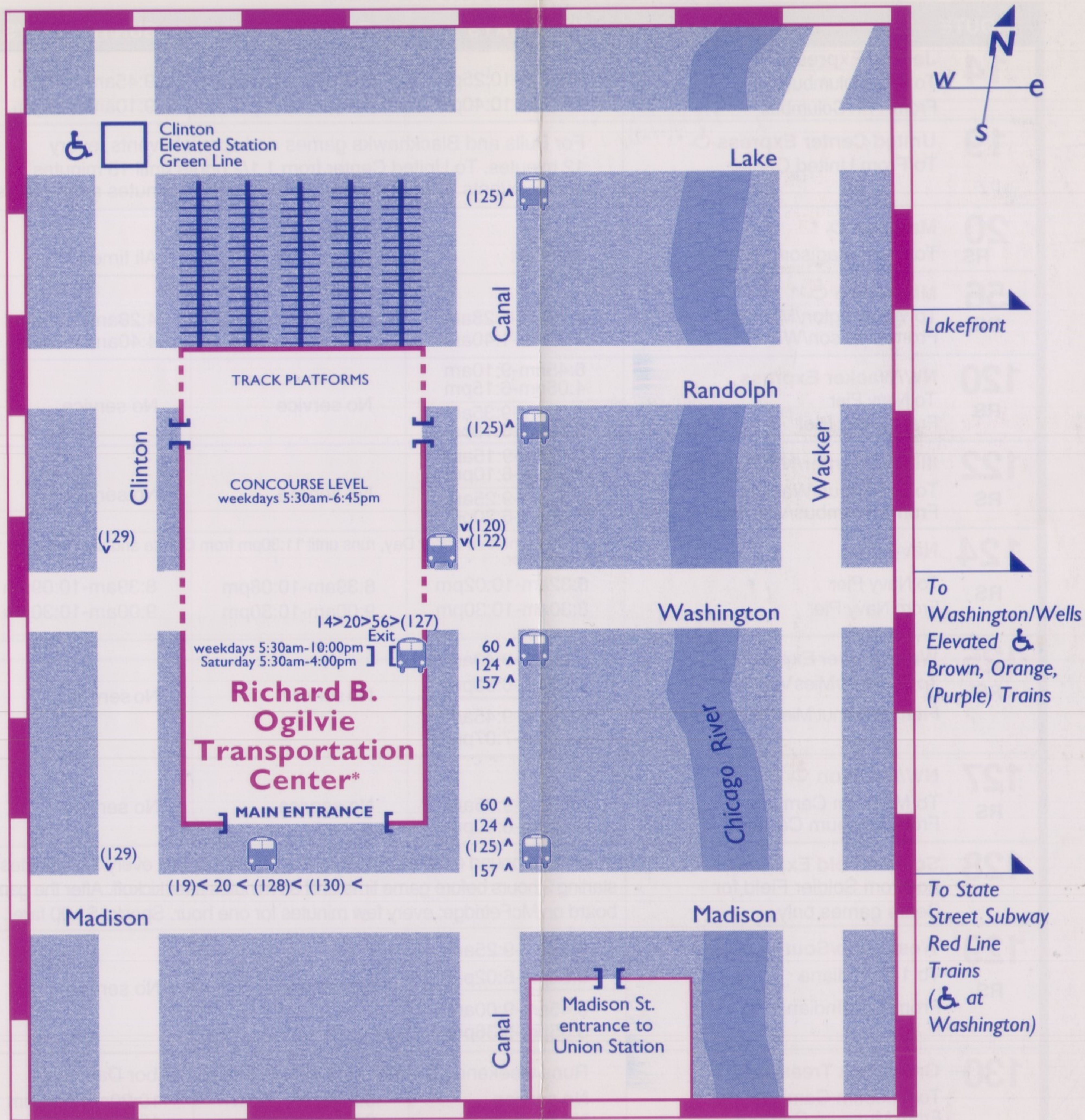


The way to really fly.

This brochure shows CTA bus and train connections from Metra's Ogilvie Transportation Center to major destinations. Directions can be used daily, unless noted. Service runs every 5-15 minutes. See time chart for service hours.

John Marshall Law School	Weekday AM rush: 129 south on Clinton. Daily: Any bus east on Washington to State; then any bus south on State
LaSalle Street Metra Station	Any bus east on Washington at Canal; ride to Dearborn; then 22 or 24 south on Clark to Van Buren
Lincoln Park Zoo/Conservatory	Any bus east on Washington at Canal; ride to Wabash; then 151 from same bus stop
Loop Tour Train	Saturday early afternoons, May through September. Get free tickets at Chicago Cultural Center (directions above)
Loyola University (downtown)	Weekday rush hours: 125 NB on Canal at Madison or Randolph Daily: Any bus east on Washington; ride to State, then ride Red Line subway train under State marked "Howard" to Chicago station; walk one block north to Pearson
McCormick Place	Any bus east on Washington at Canal; ride to Michigan; then 3 south on Michigan

Merchandise Mart	Weekday rush hours: 125 north on Canal at Madison or Randolph Other times: Any bus east on Washington to Franklin; walk 3 blocks north on Franklin
Michigan Avenue Shopping	Weekdays: 125 or 157 north on Canal at Washington. Daily: Any bus east on Washington to Wabash; then 147 or 151 from same stop
Midway Airport	Any bus east on Washington to Wabash; then Orange Line train from Randolph/Wabash 'L' station

O'Hare Airport	Any bus east on Washington at Canal; ride to Dearborn; then Blue Line subway train marked "O'Hare" under Dearborn to Airport.
Randolph St. Metra Station	60, 124 or 157 north on Canal at Washington
Randolph St. Theater District	Any bus east on Washington to Dearborn or State

Roosevelt University	14 or 127 east on Washington
Sears Tower	Walk 1 block east on Madison to Wacker, then 2 blocks south on Wacker
Shedd Aquarium/Oceanarium	14 east on Washington to Canal; ride to 11th/Columbus
Sightseeing Boats Michigan Ave. Bridge	124 north on Canal at Washington; ride to Michigan/South Water and walk one block north
Siskel Film Center	Buses 14, 20 or 56 east on Washington at Canal
Soldier Field	Bears games only: 128 west on Madison at station entrance. Daily: Any bus east on Washington at Canal; ride to State; then 146 south on State
State of Illinois (Thompson) Ctr.	Any bus east on Washington at Canal

Union Station (Amtrak/Metra)	Use Madison Street exit; cross Madison and then Canal, entrance is on Madison between Canal and the river

U.S. Cellular Field	Any bus east on Washington at Canal; ride to State; then ride Red Line subway train under State marked "95/Dan Ryan" to Sox-35th station.

Wrigley Field	Any bus east on Washington at Canal; ride to State, then ride Red Line subway train under State marked "Howard" to Addison station

- Red Line trains (State Street subway) and Blue Line trains (Dearborn Street subway) run at all times.
- Brown Line trains (Washington/Wells elevated) run weekdays/Saturday 5:15am-12:35am and Sunday/holidays 7:15am-12:05am.
- Orange Line trains (Washington/Wells elevated) run weekdays from 4:25am-1:20am, Saturday 5:05am-1:15am and Sunday 6:05am-midnight.
- Purple Line Express trains (Washington/Wells elevated) run weekdays from 6:13am-10:18am and from 3:18pm-7:18pm.
- Green Line trains run along Wabash and Lake Streets weekdays from 4:30am-1:15am and weekends from 6:30am-1:15am.



TICKET INFORMATION

MONTHLY PASS Save over 30%. Good for unlimited travel between the fare zones indicated on the ticket during a calendar month. The pass is for the exclusive use of the purchaser and is not transferable.

10-RIDE TICKET Occasional commuters or recreational travelers save 15% off one-way fares. One 10-Ride can be shared by people riding together. Ticket is valid one year from date of purchase.

ONE WAY TICKET Good for one-way travel between the fare zones indicated on the ticket. Valid for one year from date of purchase.

\$5 WEEKEND PASS Offers unlimited rides on both Saturday and Sunday.

PACE PLUSBUS Monthly pass holders can purchase a Pace PlusBus sticker for unlimited travel on all Pace suburban buses. Pace buses connect with Metra trains at many stations.

LINK-UP Monthly pass holders can purchase a Link-Up sticker for connecting travel on CTA and Pace buses. CTA usage is restricted to A.M. and P.M. weekday rush hours.

FAMILY FARES Allow up to three children under 12 to ride FREE with a fare-paying adult on weekends and holidays.

YOUNG ADULT FARES On weekends and holidays, youngsters 12 to 17 years of age ride for half fare.

CHILDREN'S WEEKDAY FARES Allow children 6 and under to ride free when accompanied by a fare-paying adult (up to three children free per adult); children 7-11 save 50% over one-way fares.

GROUP FARES You can call our group Travel office at 312.322.6772 during regular business hours for more information.

SENIOR CITIZEN/DISABILITY FARES Senior Citizens and customers with disabilities who have a RTA Reduced Fare Permit can purchase a reduced One-Way, 10-Ride or Monthly Pass.

FARES

CASH FARE Exact fare only.

TRANSFER CARD Two more rides within two hours on CTA and Pace.

TRANSIT CARD

Deducts fares & transfers on CTA and Pace. Transfers must occur within two hours of first ride. Can pay for up to 7 full-fare rides at once. Add value at rail station farecard machines. Maximum card value is \$100. **Buy full-fare cards at rail station farecard machines** for any amount between \$1.75 and \$91. Get \$1 bonus for every \$10 purchase or added value.**

CHICAGO CARD™ / CHICAGO CARD PLUS™

TRANSIT CARD PACKS

Buy at Currency Exchanges, select Jewel, Dominick's and Cub Foods stores, and at transitchicago.com. Add value at station farecard machines.

PASSES Activated with first use. Buy at Currency Exchanges, select Jewel, Dominick's and Cub Foods stores or at transitchicago.com. Passes cannot be shared or recharged. 1-day and 7-day Passes valid only on CTA.

VISITOR PASSES Activated with first use. Buy at Visitor Centers, Airports, Museums, Hot Tix, Navy Pier, CTA's website, or call 1-888-YOUR-CTA. Valid only on CTA. Passes cannot be shared or recharged.

LINK-UP PASS (STICKER)

Valid weekdays 6-9:30am, 3:30-7pm on CTA and anytime on Pace. Sold by Metra; use with Metra monthly ticket.

RUSH SHUTTLE FARES Between downtown Metra stations & Loop on certain routes. Weekdays from 6-10 am and 3:30-7:30pm (obtain brochure).
