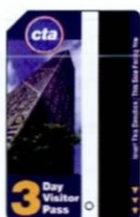
Visitor Passes activate at first use and allow unlimited riding for the number of consecutive days shown on the pass. Passes cannot be shared or recharged.

New Visitor Pass vending machines

Machines have been installed at select rail stations and visitor information centers. They accept major credit cards and debit cards for purchase, and provide audio and visual instructions in English and Spanish. Exact bills in U.S. Currency only.

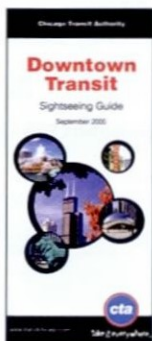
