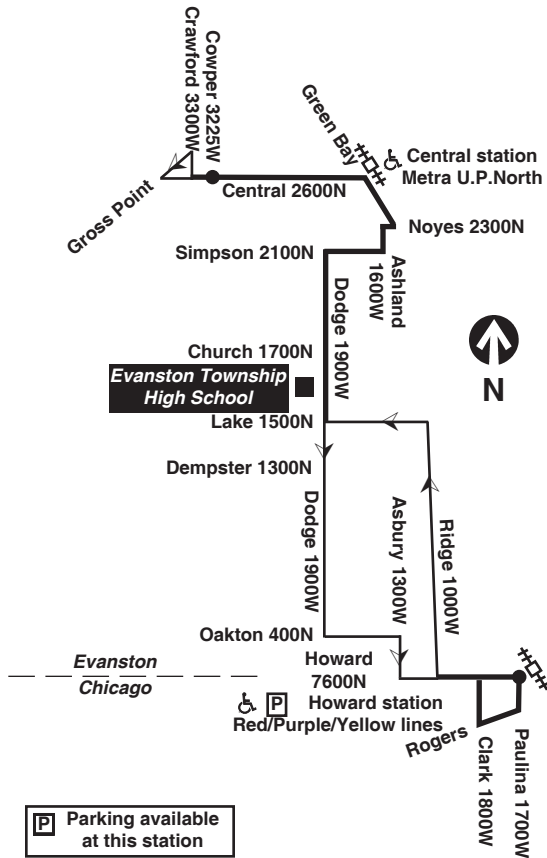

AM Route North on Ridge, South on Dodge

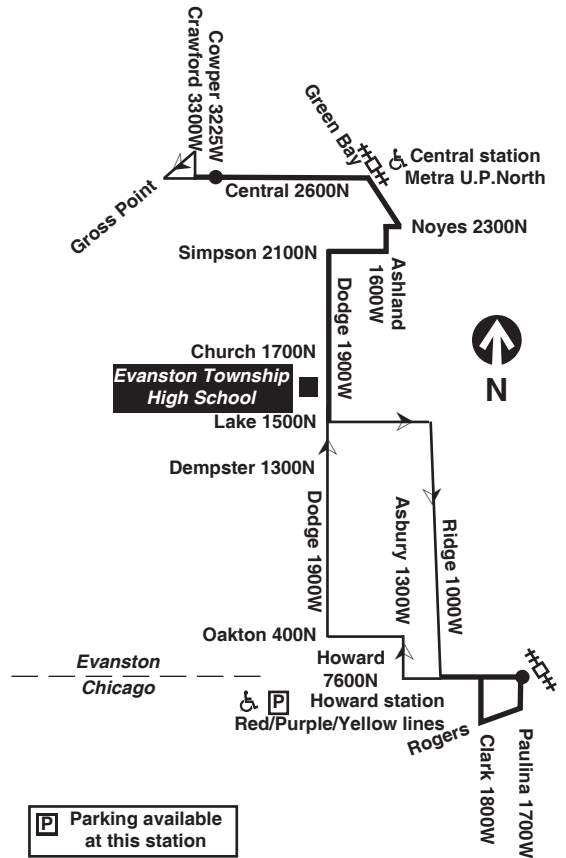

Bicycle racks are available on the front exteriors of CTA buses. Bicycles can be placed on bicycle racks during normal hours of operation for each route. Racks accommodate two (2) bicycles at a time. Bicycles are also permitted on CTA trains during certain hours.
