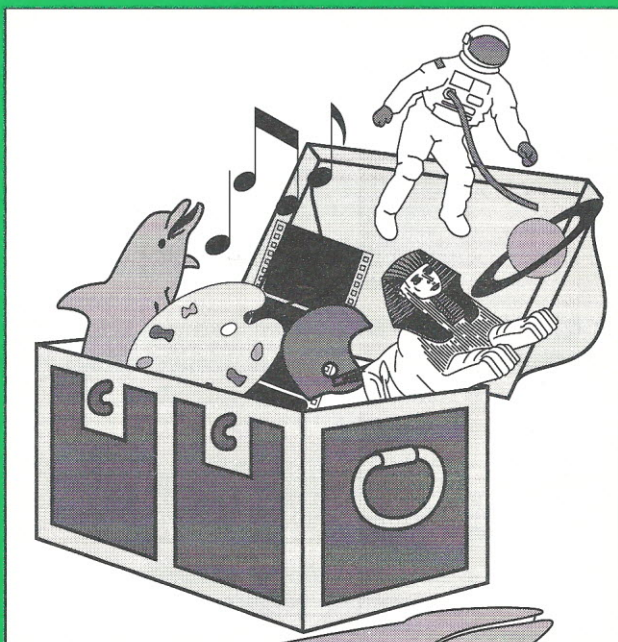

It offers direct service from NorthWestern, Union, and LaSalle St. Metra stations downtown to the Art Institute, Shedd Aquarium, Adler Planetarium, Field Museum of Natural History, and Soldier Field.

It also serves a score of theatres, smaller museums, and universities in the South Loop area.

You can board at any bus stop along the route.

The **#130** bus runs on weekends year round, and daily during summer and the Christmas holiday season.

It's simple—we provide a quick, direct route to your destination. And you don't have to worry about traffic, parking or being towed.

So come in on **Amtrak, Metra, CTA**, or park in the west Loop area—get on the **#130** and ride with us!

Adults..... **\$1.00** Reduced*..... **.40**

Adult transfer..... **.25** Reduced transfer*.. **.15**

- * Children 7-11, and seniors/disabled with RTA Reduced Fare Card. Children under 7 ride free (with fare-paying rider) except groups of unrelated children.

Route 130 Bus Schedule - Effective May 25, 1991

1. Service **EVERY DAY** from Memorial Day through Labor Day
2. Service on **WEEKENDS ONLY** from Labor Day through Memorial Day, except Daily from December 17 - 31 for the holiday season
3. Holiday service on Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, and the day **AFTER** Thanksgiving. **NO SERVICE** Thanksgiving, Christmas, or New Year's Day

At NorthWestern Station, board westbound on Madison (main station entrance). At Union Station, board eastbound on Jackson at Canal. At LaSalle St. station, board eastbound on Jackson at Financial Place.
