

New CTA Routes Serving the University of Chicago, Hyde Park and Kenwood

Starting Monday, September 18, 2000, the CTA will operate four (4) new routes that serve the University of Chicago and the surrounding communities of Hyde Park and Kenwood. University of Chicago students, faculty and staff, and community residents are welcome to use these convenient new services. The University is sharing the cost to operate the routes with the CTA.

| New Routes | Frequency / Fares |

| #170 U. of Chicago - Midway Buses will operate counterclockwise around the Midway from 59 th /Harper via 59 th , Cottage Grove, 60 th , Stony Island and 59 th back to Harper during weekday rush periods only. | Buses run every 20 minutes. U. of Chicago students, faculty & staff, and Hospital staff ride free with ID. |
| #171 U. of Chicago - Hyde Park Buses will make trips from 54 th /Shoreland to the central campus, daily, from early morning until early evening from September through mid-June, and during weekday rush periods only in the summer. | Buses run every 15 to 30 minutes. U. of Chicago students ride free with university ID. |
| #172 U. of Chicago - Kenwood Buses will make trips from East Hyde Park at East End to the central campus, daily, from morning until early evening weekdays from September through mid-June, and during rush periods only in the summer. | Buses run every 15 to 45 minutes. U. of Chicago students ride free with university ID. |
| #173 U. of Chicago - Lakeview Express Express buses will connect the campus to downtown and the North Side from September through mid-June, evenings only from 5 p.m. until 11 p.m. on weekdays and later on weekends. | Buses run every 30 to 60 minutes. Regular CTA fares apply for all customers. |

- Pay regular fares and can buy transfers to other CTA services.

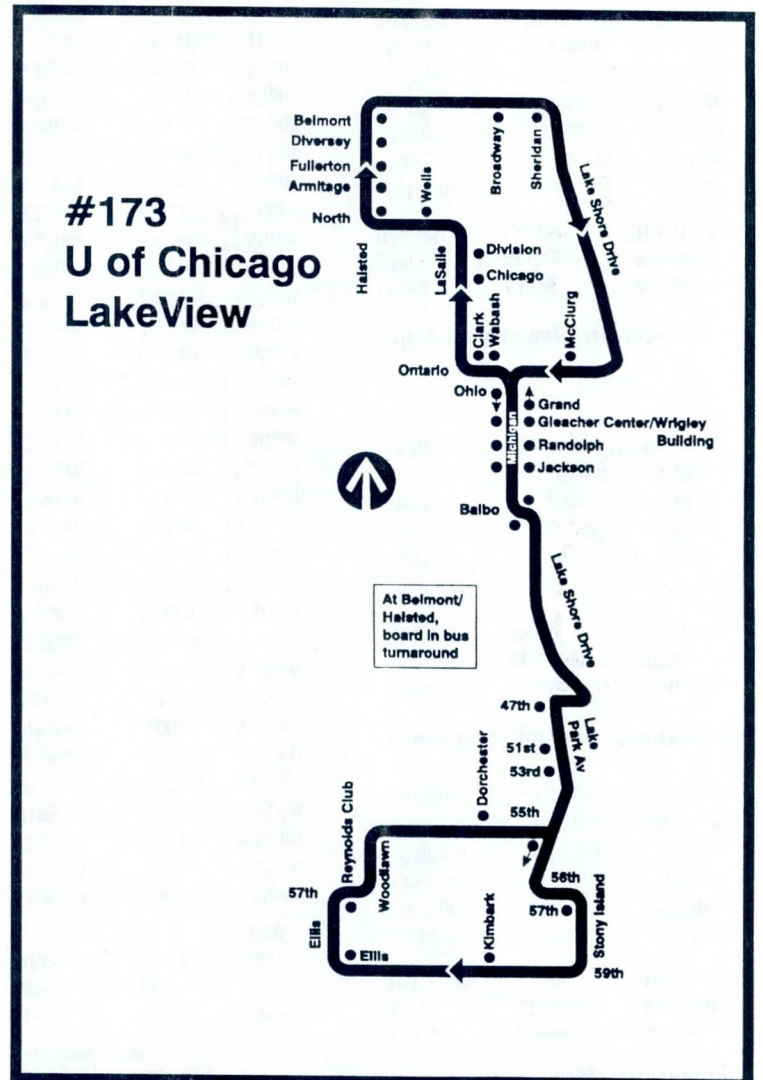
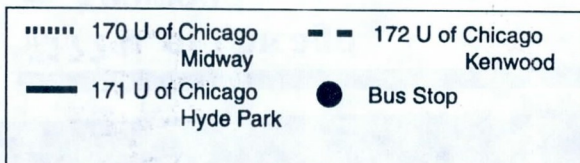
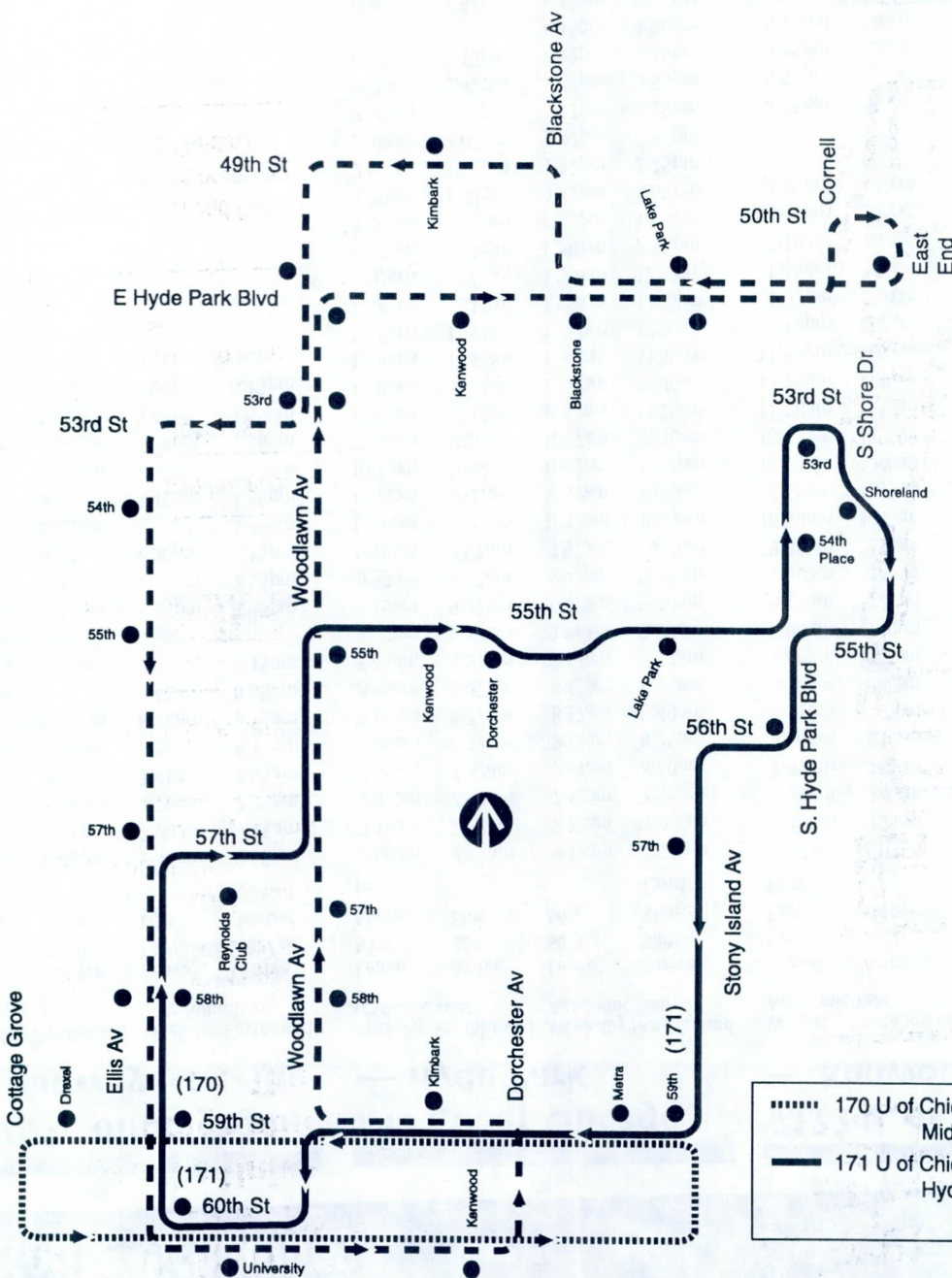
CTA Full Fares

| | |
|---------------|---|
| Cash Fare | \$1.50 – exact fare required on buses. |
| Transfer Card | 30¢ – allows two more rides in two hours on any route. |
| Transit Card | Buy Transit Cards at CTA rail stations. \$1.50 – deducted on 1st ride, .30 – deducted on 2nd use within two hours; FREE – 3rd use within two hours. |

Passes

Activated with the first use. Buy at Currency Exchanges, Jewel and Dominick's, and on the Internet at www.transitchicago.com. Passes cannot be shared or recharged. 1-day and 7-day passes valid only on CTA. \$5 (1-day); \$20 (7-day); \$75 (30-day)
